KEY FINDINGS

- Majorities of respondents across countries are concerned about climate change and see its impacts in the form of worsening natural disasters. Although in some countries notably the US, Canada, Australia, and Germany ideology tempers climate concerns among those on the right.
- Throughout the survey, respondents in South Africa express a deep concern for climate change and resentment that their government is not taking the steps to address it. While less critical of their governments, Brazilians and Mexicans are also among the most climate concerned.
- When it comes to addressing climate change, respondents view their governments and international organizations as having the most power to intervene.
- However, pluralities across countries view their government as doing "too little" to combat climate change leaving many respondents feeling that individual consumers are doing the most to combat it at the moment.
- While government bears the brunt of the responsibility, respondents also want to see corporations playing a part in the fight against climate change by providing funding.
- Aside from funding, respondents appear uncertain what role businesses should play in the fight against climate change. There is support for banks and insurance companies to disentangle themselves from fossil fuel projects, but their opinions appear malleable.




CLIMATE CHANGE CONCERN

Majorities across countries are concerned about climate change, with India, Brazil, South Africa, and Mexico expressing the strongest concern




CLIMATE CHANGE CONCERN

Ideology divides respondents in the US, Canada, and Australia on climate change concern




CLIMATE CHANGE CONCERN


Majorities across European countries are concerned about climate change, though there is some resistance among Germany's right




EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE

Countries who expressed the most concern about climate change (Brazil, South Africa, and Mexico) are critical of their country's efforts to combat it




EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE

Given the ideological cleavages, right-leaning respondents in the US and Canada feel their government is doing too much to combat climate change. While the right in Australia were less concerned about climate change, they feel their gov't is handling it properly




EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE

Right-leaning respondents in more climate concerned areas feel their government is not doing enough to combat climate change




EFFORTS TO COMBAT CLIMATE CHANGE


Additionally, a majority in South Africa also believe the government is doing less than their fair share

Given their strong climate change concern, South Africans are most likely to say their country's efforts to combat it are not ambitious enough


And would you say your country's efforts to combat climate change are too ambitious, not ambitious enough, or just right?

Respondents generally believe their government, followed by international organizations have the most power to combat climate change


Who do you believe has the most power to combat climate change?

With few believing that corporations are currently doing the most to combat climate change, respondents want to see corporations bearing the costs of combating change



Strong majorities believe that wealthier countries should support lower income countries to combat climate change with particularly strong support in Brazil and SA


Should wealthy countries pay to help lower-income countries combat climate change?

Which of the following comes closest to your opinion, even if neither is exactly right?









There's an appetite among consumers to fly with a climate conscious airline, but the data suggests few would be willing to pay much more to do so

While not the most climate conscious country, Russia strongly believes that fossil fuel companies should be held responsible for their environmental impacts


Should fossil fuel companies be held responsible for the impacts their products have on the environment?

With limited background on bank funding for fossil fuel projects, respondents are split as to whether they should continue funding them


As you may know, some banks finance fossil fuel projects like oil drilling, coal, and natural gas plants. Which of the following comes closest to your opinion?


