Hi Mandy,

Barring there being a state of national emergency tomorrow or something, my understanding is resignation requests will need to be sent out. Kathryn Smith passed along the attached resignation letter template, which has apparently been approved by OGC, to guide people. That request will prompt Lance McCluney's team to send 1/20-dated SF-52s out to appointees, and the various offices to set up OneDrives for offboarding.

If that all sounds right, there are three things to clarify:

1. I think when we met on Monday you said that letters can be sent to the Administrator's public email, cc'ing you and myself. Since that is not included instructions in the attached template or in the OMS guidance, that should probably be specified in the body of the instruction/request email.
2. Kathryn and Dorothy wondered if, since the AD's serve directly at the discretion of the Administrator, a resignation request to ADs should come from his office rather than your office.
3. Related to ADs, since this would mean she was not to be included in such an email, is it true that Abigail Linsk, Ex. 6 will not be asked to resign? Just want to confirm what I've heard, and if so, note that the above won't apply to her so all involved are on the same page.
