Hi Monica and Heather – In this latest draft of the recusal memo, we confirmed that my recusal will extend to certain particular matters that involve The Wilderness Society, in addition to the National Audubon Society. As we discussed, the initial direction from you was that the recusal only extended to the National Audubon Society, my most recent employer. In the interim, I did participate in one meeting on June 1st with The Wilderness Society along with 2 folks from the Department of the Interior (Elizabeth Klein and Alexandra Sanchez) to discuss oil and gas policy generally, in the context of Interior's ongoing review of the program, and policy aimed at reducing/offsetting climate change impacts more broadly. We did not touch on any particular matters at that meeting but it did not include the additional number of organizations I would now ensure were part of any such meeting. I will comply with the recusal requirements going forward, of course.
