Notice of Southeast Energy Exchange Market Commencement Date

Dear Secretary Bose:

The Southeast Energy Exchange Market (“Southeast EEM”) Members¹ hereby notify the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) of the commencement of operations of

the Southeast EEM, which will occur on November 9, 2022 (“Commencement Date”).²

Under Sections 4.1.9(a)(vi) and 8.4.2 of the Southeast EEM Agreement, the Membership Board is required to approve and establish the Southeast EEM Commencement Date after the Effective Date occurs and after the issuance by the Commission of an order or orders accepting all of the Jurisdictional Member Participating Transmission Providers’ Tariff Filings. The Effective Date of the Agreement occurred on October 12, 2021.³ Additionally, the Commission has accepted all Jurisdictional Member Participating Transmission Providers’ Tariff Filings.⁴ Accordingly, in consultation with the Southeast EEM Operating Committee, the Membership Board has approved and established the Commencement Date of the Southeast EEM, anticipated to be November 9, 2022. The Members commit to updating the Commission should the Commencement Date occur after November 9, 2022 for any reason.
