I hope everyone is having a great week and was able to check out the <u>message and video that Administrator Regan sent</u> last week about recruiting new employees to EPA. It is great to see so much excitement about this agency, the work that we do, and the people that make it an amazing place to work. As we recruit the next generation of EPA employees, I'm excited to remind you about the hiring webinar we are hosting tomorrow and enlist your help in spreading the word.

EPA announced our "Be EPA" hiring campaign last summer to support our efforts to hire more than 1,800 new employees to implement the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and the Inflation Reduction Act. And I'm proud to say that thanks to incredibly hard work by hiring managers and human resources staff across the agency, we have filled over 1,300 of those BIL and IRA positions!

As successful as we have been in hiring so many new colleagues, we have nearly 400 BIL and IRA positions to recruit for this year. These positions are in addition to the hundreds of other vacancy announcements for critical jobs across the agency.

To continue delivering on our hiring goals and to attract even more new hires to the agency, we will be hosting a special **Be EPA Hiring Webinar** (exit) on Feb. 7 at 2 p.m. ET. Our goal is to make this hiring event the biggest one we have ever had!
