This fiscal year, GSA will conduct baseline testing of potable water systems in approximately 1,400 federally owned properties and 6,000 leased locations, as per an update to its water quality management order. As a preventative approach, this baseline testing aims to evaluate the present state of GSA-controlled facilities' water distribution systems and determine whether long-term maintenance improvements, system updates, or both are required to fulfill the standards of their new water quality order. As a result, GSA has scheduled with our building lessor for the Dallas Main office building at the Renaissance Tower to test the drinking water on EPA floors beginning at 7 a.m. on Thursday, August 15. The contractor will be escorted by the Ren Tower Engineering Team, and the process will take several hours.

Various sinks, showers, and water fountains will be turned off beginning Wednesday, August 14th at 5 p.m. to allow for testing the next morning; signs will be posted indicating not to use during this time. Rest assured, there will be plenty of sinks, showers, and water fountains to use in the meantime. After testing, the device will be turned back on for use and the signs removed. If this impacts your work schedule, please discuss an alternative schedule with your supervisor. Thank you in advance for your time and cooperation, and we apologize for any inconvenience this may create.
