Thanks to your efforts, Congress passed a series of measures in 2015 that will help ensure freight railroads continue in their vital role as the strong backbone of the American economy. We applaud you and your colleagues who supported these measures and we thank you for your leadership.

Congressional actions providing a realistic timetable for implementing positive train control, enhancing safety requirements for tank cars carrying flammable liquids, extending the short line tax credit, and streamlining the permitting process for rail infrastructure projects will provide tangible benefits to communities across the United States that depend on railroads to connect them to the global economy.
