- 2 SEC. ____ . (a) Congress finds that—
- 3 (1) climate change is real;
- 4 (2) human activity contributes to climate
- 5 change;
- 6 (3) climate change is already affecting the peo-
- 7 ple of the United States and poses an increasing risk
- 8 to—

1 (A) the health of the people of the United
2 States; and

3 (B) the security, economy, and infrastruc-
4 ture of the United States; and

5 (4) over 180 countries, including China, India,
6 and Brazil, have made commitments to reducing
7 greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to climate
8 change, which creates opportunities for workers of
9 the United States and innovative private industries
10 to benefit from global clean energy markets.

11 (b) It is the sense of Congress that—

12 (1) the United States should be a world leader
13 in addressing climate change;

14 (2) Congress is best positioned to address poli-
15 cies that leave for future generations a prosperous
16 economy and healthy environment;

17 (3) Congress has a responsibility to take actions
18 that reduce emissions and combat climate change;

20 (4) Congress should support research and devel-
21 opment to bolster clean energy technology.
