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HHS Projects Another Million Obamacare Enrollees in 2017

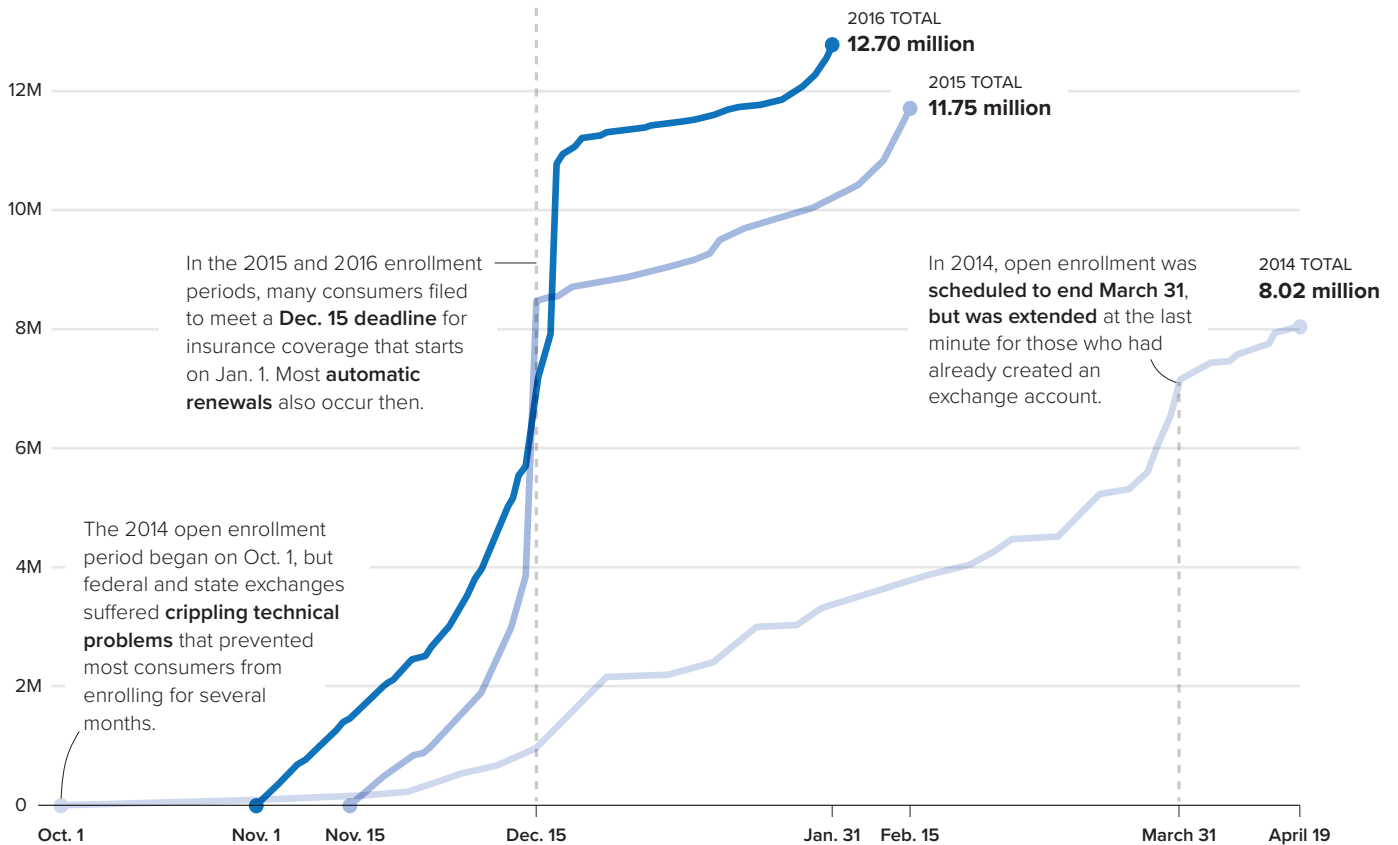
During the fourth open enrollment period, which begins on Nov. 1, 2017, HHS projects that 13.8 million people will select plans on the Affordable Care Act marketplaces, resulting in average monthly paid enrollment of 11.4 million individuals over the course of the year. This suggests that enrollment will grow by approximately 1 million individuals compared with last year, although it will remain well below the CBO's initial estimates when the law was written. HHS estimates that 9.2 million of this year's enrollees will be re-enrollees with 2016 marketplace coverage, 3.5 million will be uninsured and 1.1 million will have had off-marketplace non-group coverage.
