On behalf of the National Alliance for Public Charter Schools, I am writing to support the nomination of Betsy DeVos to serve as the U.S. Secretary of Education. I urge the Committee to confirm her nomination.

Mrs. DeVos has been a dedicated champion for improving education for all students. As a result of her work with organizations dedicated to education reform, countless children throughout America are now able to access a higher quality education. As Secretary of Education we expect that her leadership will guide the Administration's budget and policies toward increased academic outcomes for all of our nation's students

Moreover, her extensive record of empowering families with school choice demonstrates that she will continue to be a strong advocate for charter public schools, including their students, parents and teachers. Charter schools are granted operational autonomy in exchange for meeting specific accountability goals: if goals are not met, the charter school is no longer permitted to remain open. As supporters of autonomy and accountability, we strongly supported the changes made in the recent reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act through the *Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)*.
