Dear Representative:

Today, the Committee on Rules will consider amendments to H.R. 3354, legislation which includes the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development, and Related Agencies, or THUD bill. There are several amendments that have been submitted that repeal and weaken current truck safety laws and regulations. The proposed amendments are major policy and regulatory changes that have not been subject to any House hearings, public input or agency review. We urge you to reject all of them.

Truck crash deaths and injuries have been increasing significantly and unabated. According to the U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT), 4,067 people were needlessly killed in crashes involving large trucks in 2015. This represents a 20 percent increase since 2009. Furthermore, 116,000 people were injured -- the largest number of injuries since 2004, and a 57 percent increase since 2009. The annual death and injury toll of truck crashes as well as the upward trends are completely unacceptable and attacks on safety rules would never be tolerated in any other mode of transportation.

For these reasons, we strongly urge you to oppose the following amendments:

- Amendment #35 (offered by Reps. Babin (R-TX), Smucker (R-PA) and LaMalfa (R-CA)) prohibits funds from being used to implement or enforce a rule that takes effect in December 2017 requiring Electronic Logging Devices (ELDs) on commercial motor vehicles (CMVs). The requirement for ELDs was passed with bipartisan support in the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21, Pub. L. 112-141). This safety improvement had broad support from safety and public health groups, law enforcement, truck crash families and survivors, the Teamsters and other trucking interests -- and for good reason. The U.S. DOT estimated annualized net benefits of adopting ELDs to be over \$1 billion. Moreover, the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) has repeatedly recommended that all trucks and buses be equipped with logging devices. Fatigue is a well-known and well-documented safety problem and ELDs are a critical tool to ensure compliance with hours of service rules and combat the deadly consequences of tired truckers.
- Amendment #60 (offered by Reps. Perry (R-PA), LaMalfa (R-CA) and Meadows (R-NC)) prohibits the use of funds for the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) to finalize a rulemaking on speed limiting devices for large trucks. On average, over 1,000 people are needlessly killed annually because of speeding trucks. This lifesaving technology is already installed on most large trucks. High speeds and large trucks are a deadly combination. A 2012 study by FMCSA found that trucks without a speed limiting device had twice as many speed related crashes as those trucks equipped with a speed limiter.
- Amendment #84 (offered by Reps. DeSaulnier (D-CA), Davis (R-IL) and Smucker (R-PA)) would prohibit funds from being used to enforce weight limits up to 82,000 pounds for trucks powered by electric batteries. Encouraging alternative energy use in large trucks should not be achieved by hand-cuffing law enforcement from enforcing truck

weight limit laws and regulations and compromising safety. Overweight trucks are a serious safety threat to motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists and bigger trucks inflict even bigger damage to already-crumbling roads and bridges.

These amendments on behalf of special trucking interests will have adverse safety ramifications for families in your districts that share the road with large trucks. Before today is over, 11 people will be killed and over 300 injured in a large truck crash. We strongly urge you to reject all anti-truck safety amendments to the appropriations bill.
