Dear Chairman Gowdy:

I am writing in response to your September 26, 2017, letter regarding the use of government-owned or private non-commercial aircraft by non-career officials. Since January 20, 2017, the Department's non-career employees have not used government aircraft for personal travel or private non-commercial aircraft for official travel.

The following table outlines the usage of government-owned aircraft by non-career officials for official travel at the Department of Labor since January 20, 2017.
