DATE: JANUARY 23, 2018

In a recently completed survey of likely Republican primary voters (GOP PV) (*survey methodology statement on final page*) in Tennessee's 6th Congressional district, Fabrizio, Lee & Associates found that the Republican primary for the 6th Congressional District is wide open.

• All three major candidates are unknown or undefined to the vast majority of voters.

Despite both being in the race for months and spending hundreds of thousands of dollars, the two previously announced candidates, John Rose and Judd Matheny, have relatively little awareness among Republican primary voters.

Among GOP PV, 89% have no opinion or have never heard of Judd Matheny, and 87% of voters have no opinion or have never heard of John Rose. This is notable as you decide on whether or not to enter this race as, similar to the two announced candidates, 89% of Republican primary voters in CD-6 have no opinion or have never heard of you.

<u>METHODOLOGY STATEMENT</u>: Fabrizio, Lee & Associates conducted a districtwide survey of 400 likely Republican primary voters via landline and cell phone on January 14-15, 2018 in Tennessee's 6^{th} Congressional district. Landline interviews accounted for 60% of the sample and cell phone interviews 40%. Geography by county were matched to the Republican primary turnout in recent primary elections. Gender, age, and race/ethnicity were matched to the population of previous Republican primary voters according to a state-provided voter file. Respondents were randomly selected from lists of previous primary voters. The margin of error at the 95% confidence interval for 400 voters is $\pm 4.90\%$.
