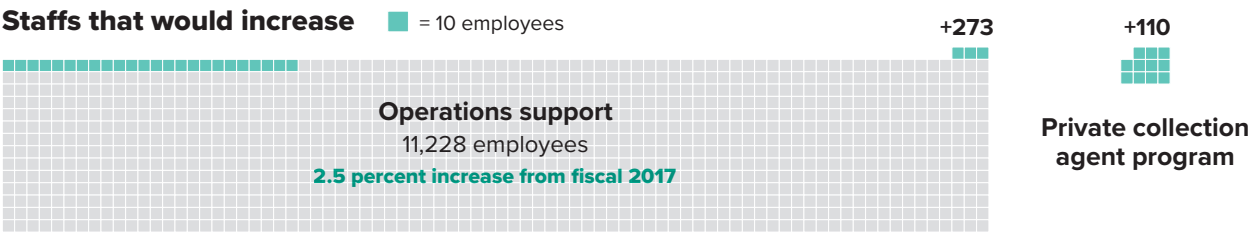
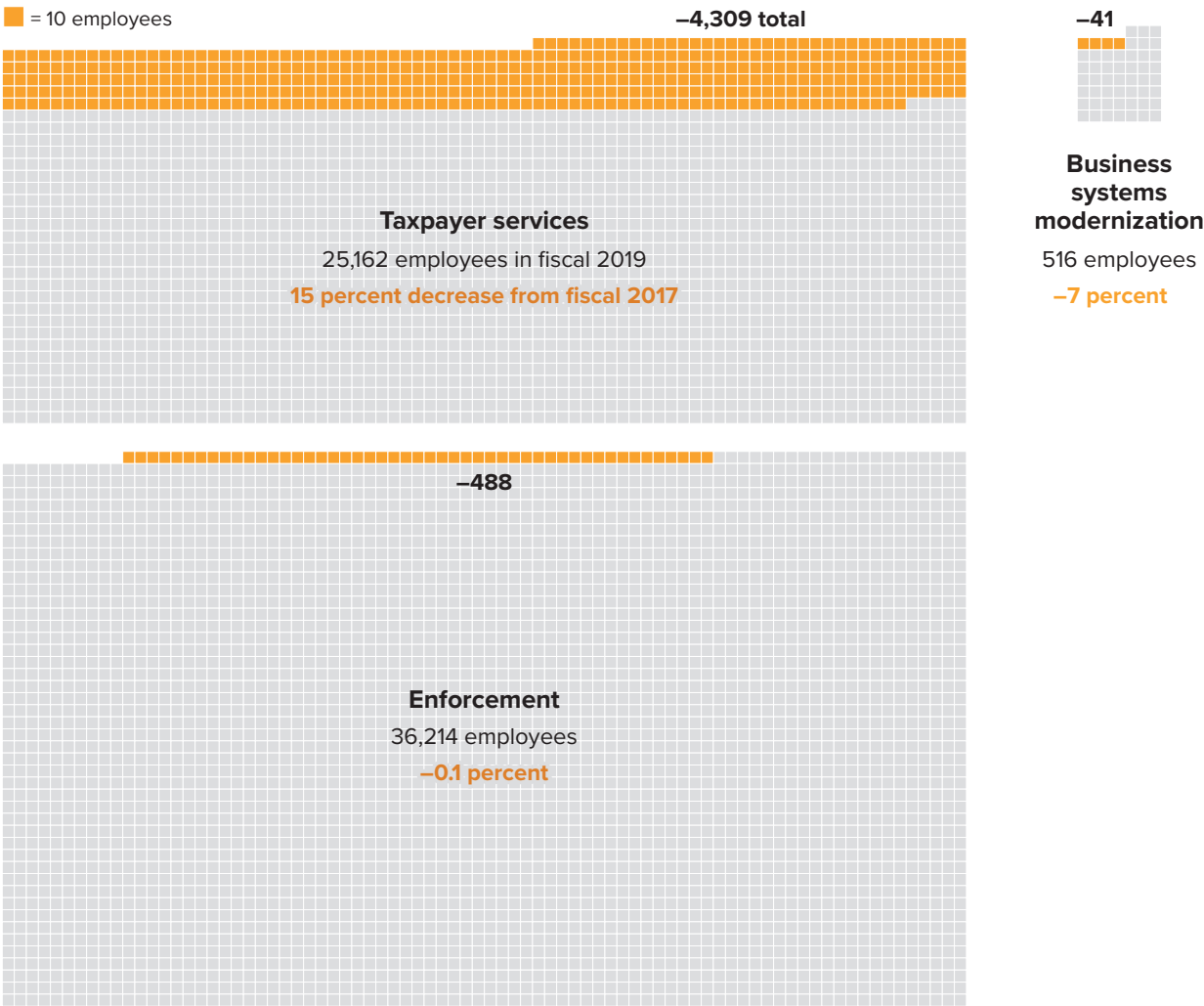

Trump Budget: Shrink IRS By 4,000 Employees

President Donald Trump’s budget request would make cuts across many agencies, including the IRS. The cuts would come at the same time the department is fully implementing the new tax law — its workforce would decrease by about six percent, or 4,455 workers, from 2017 levels. Most reductions would come from decreasing the number of workers in taxpayer services. The budget would also employ workers to oversee tax collection by private collection agents.
