

U.S. Fossil Fuel Trade with Mexico

As U.S. oil and gas production increased, the U.S. energy trade balance with Mexico shifted, from an energy-trade deficit of \$29.8 billion eight years ago to an energy-trade surplus of \$16 billion in 2017. That could change if the Trump administration weakens NAFTA, allowing China to snag more of Mexico's market share, according to Sempra Energy executive vice president Dennis Arriola, who raised the warning at a Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute summit.



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
