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with the Secretary of Homeland Security and the Director
 of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, \$20,000,000 for
 each of fiscal years 2018 through 2022 to investigate and
 prosecute website operators that criminally facilitate sex
 trafficking or the sexual exploitation of children.
