Summary and Threat Statistics

The EPA OIG statutory authority under the Inspector General Act of 1978 authorizes EPA OIG special agents full law enforcement authority to (1) carry firearms, (2) serve subpoenas, (3) make arrests, (4) execute search and seizure warrants (5), administer and take oaths, (6), unrestricted access to all EPA records, information, facilities, and personnel per U.S. law and EPA regulations.

The EPA OIG investigates allegations of fraud against EPA, employee misconduct, intrusion into EPA computers and systems, the impersonating of EPA officials, counterfeiting or misuse of EPA official insignia, theft of EPA property or funds and threats against EPA employees, contractors, facilities or assets. EPA OIG is also responsible for investigating assaults on EPA employees and other acts of violence committed in EPA facilities.

Threats Directed Against EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt and Family

1. COMP-2017-75: This investigation was predicated upon an investigative referral which stated that the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of the EPA Administrator was receiving threats on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Facebook account. The threats were directed toward (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). The threat stated "I hope your (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dies soon, suffering as your (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) watches in horror for hours on end." This investigation is ongoing.

2. OI-HQ-2016-CAC-0032: (b) (7)(A)

3. OI-DA-2017-CAC-0096: OIG agents discovered a threatening Twitter post directed towards Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell and EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt. Investigators interviewed the subject, who admitted to posting the tweets in question. This investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office and subsequently declined for prosecution. This case was worked jointly with FBI and U.S. Capitol Police (USCP).
4. OI-DA-2017-CAC-0102: The EPA OIG was notified that an email had been received in the Capitol Hill office of Oklahoma Senator, James Lankford threatening to assassinate EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt, President Donald Trump and Vice President Mike Pence. The subject was interviewed and stated (b) (6) intended no harm. This investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office and subsequently declined for prosecution. The EPA, Security Management Division issued a Bar Notice for the subject. This case was worked jointly with U.S. Secret Service (USSS) and USCP.
5. OI-CH-2017-CAC-0101: The EPA OIG received notification of a potential threat on social media against the EPA Administrator. The subject stated (b) (6) is not happy with some of the Administrator's policies and wanted to express (b) (6) displeasure. This investigation was presented and declined by the United States Attorney's Office.
6. COMP-2017-47: The EPA OIG received a letter addressed to the EPA Administrator. Special agents conducted a review of the contents of the letter. The letter did not reveal any overt threatening language. An open source search of the subject revealed that the subject is currently incarcerated. This a copy of the letter was forwarded back to prison officials.
7. OI-HQ-2017-CAC-0095: (b) (7)(A)
8. OI-BO-2017-CAC-0093: (b) (7)(A)
9. OI-HQ-2017-CAC-0078: (b) (7)(A)
10. OI-CH-2017-CAC-0077: The subject of the investigation sent a potentially threatening postcard to the EPA Administrator. EPA OIG interviewed the subject who expressed regret and apologized for sending the postcard. During the interview which took place at the subject's residence, (b) (6) was wearing two handguns on (b) (6) waist. This investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office and subsequently declined for prosecution.

11. OI-BO-2017-CAC-0076: The EPA Administrator received a potentially threatening postcard which states; "Get out while you still can, Scott, you are evil incarnate you ignorant fuck." The investigation was unable to determine a subject and the case was not presented to the United States Attorney's Office for prosecution.

14. OI-NE-2017-CAC-0029: A letter was received by the EPA OIG and reviewed by Special Agents. It was determined that while the letter was full of disjointed thoughts, the letter was not considered by the EPA OIG to contain an actual threat. The investigation was closed.

Threats Directed Against Former EPA Administrator Gina McCarthy

1. OI-HQ-2017-CAC-0043: (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), (b) (7)(A)

2. OI-DA-2017-CAC-0021: The EPA Administrator received a potentially threatening email which stated in the subject line: "Ban glyphosate or die you haggard nazi bitch! DIEDIEDIEDIEDIEDIEDIE." Investigations further revealed the subject had sent threatening emails to then Presidential candidate Hillary Clinton. Investigators interviewed the subject who admitted to sending the threatening emails, but stated that (b) (6) would not hurt anyone because (b) (6) does not leave (b) (6) house. During the interview, the subject had an SK-47 assault rifle standing in the corner of the room. Investigators coordinated with other law enforcement officials regarding the past and current mental instabilities displayed by the subject. This investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office for prosecution and subsequently declined. This case was worked jointly with the USSS.

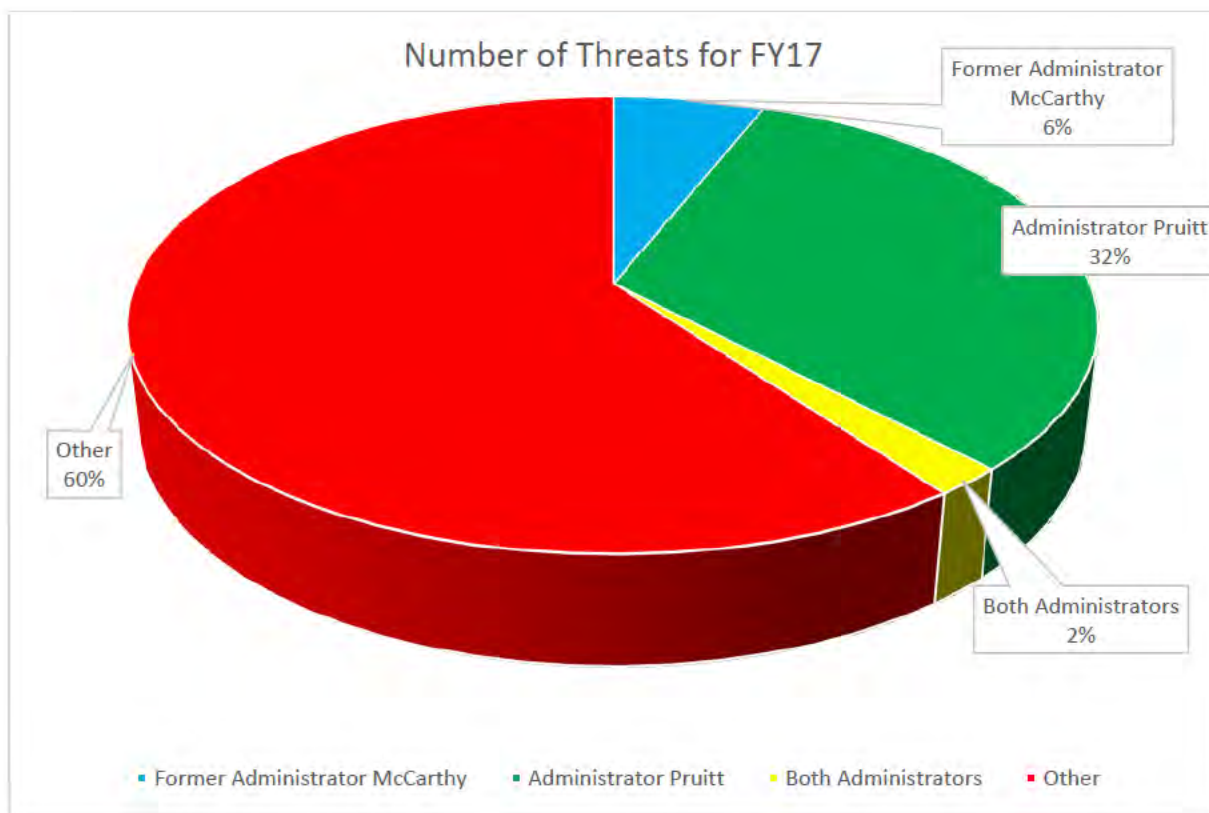
Threats Directed Against EPA Employees or Facilities

1. OI-CH-2017-THT-0137: The subject in this investigation discussed committing suicide with another employee while at an EPA facility. The subject was barred from the facility until further notice. The investigation is ongoing.
2. COMP-2017-51: A security officer assigned to monitor EPA facilities was terminated following an online threat to a coworker. The employee was subsequently barred from all EPA facilities by the EPA Security Management Division.

4. OI-DE-2017-CAC-0118: (b) (7)(A)

5. OI-AT-2017-CAC-0109: A former EPA contractor threatened to cause "bodily harm" to former supervisor. The evidence gathered was inconclusive and was not presented for prosecution. A bar notice was issued by the EPA, Security Management Division. (b) (6)
6. OI-HQ-2017-ADM-0071: (b) (7)(A)

7. OI-DE-2017-CAC-0063: The EPA OIG was notified of a suspicious package later identified as an ammunition canister found approximately 20 feet from the handicap entrance of an EPA regional office. A review of the surveillance video and subsequent interviews provided no leads to identify a suspect. The United States Attorney's Office declined prosecution of this investigation. This case was worked jointly with Federal Protective Service (FPS).
8. OI-DE-2017-CAC-0065: The EPA OIG initiated an investigation due to an altercation in which the subject may have verbally threatened EPA personnel. The allegation in this investigation is not supported and the United States Attorney's Office declined prosecution.
9. OI-AT-2017-CAC-0064: (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), (b) (7)(A)

10. OI-HQ-2017-CAC-0059: Following a sentencing for an environmental crime investigation conducted by the Criminal Investigations Division (CID), the subject of this investigation entered an elevator with an EPA employee (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and stated; "I hope to see you again real soon." An interview of the subject revealed that (b) (6) did not mean for (b) (6) comment to be taken as threatening. The United States Attorney's Office declined prosecution of this matter. This case was worked jointly with the FBI.
11. OI-SE-2017-CAC-0058: (b) (7)(A) [REDACTED]
12. OI-DE-2017-CAC-0055: An EPA employee received a potentially threatening social media message by a former EPA employee. The former employee was interviewed, admitted to the social media posting and subsequently apologized for the posting. A bar notice was issued by Security Management Division denying the subject access to the EPA regional facility. The United States Attorney's Office declined prosecution of the investigation.
13. OI-SE-2017-CAC-0038: This investigation was initiated in regards to violence in the workplace. A family member potentially made threatening remarks against an EPA employee. The subject stated that (b) (6) was prepared to come to the EPA facility and claimed that (b) (6) was also prepared to get arrested. A bar notice was issued by the EPA Security Management Division for the subject. This investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office and subsequently declined.
14. OI-HQ-2017-CAC-0020: The EPA OIG received notice of termination for an EPA employee. As the employee was escorted to (b) (6) office to remove personal items, (b) (6) made a potentially threatening gesture and comment toward (b) (6) supervisor. The investigation supported the allegation and this investigation was presented to the United States Attorney's Office for prosecution and subsequently declined. The subject was removed from Federal service.

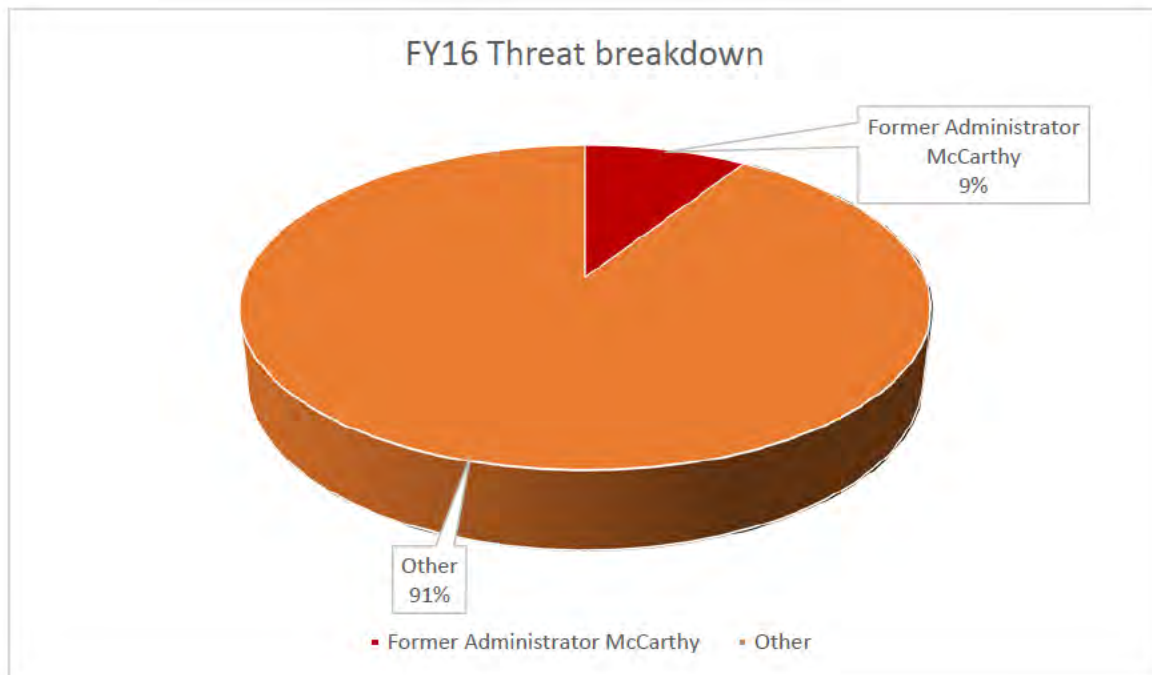

COMPLAINT: On February 24, 2017, Patrick Sullivan, Assistant Inspector General for Investigations (AIGI), Office of Investigations (OI), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received a package from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the EPA Administrator (b) (6), (b) (7)(C). At the direction of AIGI Sullivan, the matter was opened as a complaint.

SUMMARY: The contents of the package were reviewed on February 27, 2017. The package contained a three ring binder with various documents. The documents inside of the binder were examined and it was determined that no threatening language was incorporated in any of the various documents. The binder was provided to the EPA Administrator's staff for further review.

RECOMMENDATION: Based upon the foregoing, no evidence of further mailings and lack of an overt threat, it is recommended that this complaint be closed. If new or additional information is received, the EPA OIG will reassess this matter.

COMPLAINT:

On March 6, 2017, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Office of Homeland Security (OHS), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sent an email to Patrick Sullivan, Assistant Inspector General for Investigations (AIGI), Office of Investigations (OI), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regarding two letters addressed to the EPA Administrator.

SUMMARY:

On March 7, 2017, SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) conducted a review of all the contents in both envelopes. The reporting agent did not observe any overt threatening language against the EPA Administrator, EPA Facilities or EPA personnel.

In addition, On March 7, 2017, SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) conducted an open source internet search on the State of California Inmate locator website. The search revealed that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) is currently incarcerated at Salinas Valley Prison since (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) 2011 and was convicted for Offense Code 288.7(b), Oral Copulation/Sexual Penetration with a Victim Under 10 Years.

On April 17, 2017, SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) provided a copy of the letter to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), Investigative Service Unit, Salinas Valley State Prison for any action they deem appropriate. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) informed SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) that the inmate is currently residing (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) unit and that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) would review the letter and take appropriate action.

RECOMMENDATION: Based upon the aforementioned and the lack of an overt threat in this investigation, this matter is recommended for closure. If new or additional information is received, the EPA, OIG will reassess this matter.

COMPLAINT:

On March 6, 2017, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Office of Homeland Security (OHS), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) sent an email to Patrick Sullivan, Assistant Inspector General for Investigations (AIGI), Office of Investigations (OI), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regarding two letters addressed to the EPA Administrator.

SUMMARY:

On March 7, 2017, SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) conducted a review of all the contents in both envelopes. The reporting agent did not observe any overt threatening language against the EPA Administrator, EPA Facilities or EPA personnel.

SA (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) conducted a review of all the contents in both envelopes and did not see any threatening communication. Below is an analysis of the contents envelope #1. A separate analysis of the contents in envelope #2 was conducted under complaint COMP-017-47.

Envelope #1 from Unidentified Sender:

- The envelope was addressed to the EPA at 1200 Pennsylvania Ave, NW 1101-A, Washington, D.C. 20460. *[Agent Note: The envelope address line contained various letters or words which were incomprehensible following the addressee EPA. In addition, the envelope encompassed mail code 1101-A which is designated to the Office of the Administrator at the EPA and includes many EPA employees within that office. A review of the EPA Workplace: National Locator could not identify a specific EPA employee for*

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which the envelope may be addressed.] In addition, the envelope was not specifically addressed to the EPA Administrator or any other EPA personnel.

- The envelope was post-marked on February 21, 2017 from Orlando, Florida. No return address was included on the envelope.
- A review of the contents of the letter was conducted on March 7, 2017. While the communication contained offensive racial verbiage, the communication contained no overt threat to EPA facilities or personnel.
- The sender of the communication was not found within the contents of the letter and is unidentified at this time.

RECOMMENDATION: Based upon the aforementioned and the lack of an overt threat in this investigation, this matter is recommended for closure. If new or additional information is received, the EPA, OIG will reassess this matter.

COMPLAINT:

On June 6, 2017, Special Agent (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Office of Professional Responsibility (OPR), Office of Investigations (OI), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) learned from Patrick Sullivan, Assistant Inspector General for Investigations (AIGI), Office of Investigations (OI), Office of Inspector General, EPA, that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Protective Service Detail (PSD), Office of Criminal Enforcement, Forensic and Training (OCEFT), EPA, submitted an investigative referral regarding (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Administrator Scott Pruitt's (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) receiving Facebook threats which were directed at (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

SUMMARY:

Prior to OI's involvement, there were emails exchanged between ASAC (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) and (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Global Security Investigations, Facebook, regarding (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) complaint. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) advised (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to have (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) report the incident online to Facebook.

OI INVOLVEMENT:

On June 6, 2017, OI Agents conducted a phone interview with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) informed OIG agents that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not normally check (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) messages often, but received a message alert in April 2017. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) informed investigators that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not open the aforementioned messages until June 5, 2017. After opening and reviewing the content of the messages, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) reported the concerning communication to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

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OI Agents learn that a Facebook messenger using the name of (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) sent concerning communications via Facebook messenger to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) on March 9, 2017, May 12, 2017 and May 21, 2017. The most concerning of these messages dated May 21, 2017, (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) sent "I hope your (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) dies soon, suffering as your (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) watches in horror for hours on end", to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) stated that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) suspected that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) deleted (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Facebook account because (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) could not find the message to report the incident to Facebook security.

[Investigators Note: (1) The phone connection was disconnected and efforts to conclude the interview were unsuccessful on June 6 and June 7th, 2017].

After the phone interview on June 6, 2017 was disconnected (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) contacted the reporting agent and advised that (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to finish the interview with OI special agents.

On June 7, 2017, the reporting agent contacted (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) via email asking (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) if (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) was still planning to meet with OI today to conclude the interview. The reporting agent also attempted to contact (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) via (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) cell phone.

[Investigators Note: (1). No response from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (2). (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) with the Administrator. 7JUN2017]

On June 8, 2017, the reporting agent left a voicemail on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) cell phone.

[Investigators Note: (1). No return call from (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (2) To date, multiple attempts have been made to make contact with (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) for additional details concerning the Facebook communications, with no success.]

COMPLAINT: On February 13, 2017, Special Agent (SA) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations (OI), Washington Field Office, 1200 Pennsylvania Ave, NW, Washington, DC 20460, was asked to investigate revised Hotline Complaint #2017-124; regarding - *"A potential threat to the EPA in future activity in the State of Virginia"*. An unidentified caller from a blocked number called the Region 3 Customer Service Hotline in Philadelphia and left the following message; *"Pruitt is going to clean up the EPA. Stay out of our [s]tate Virginia"*; nothing further.

BACKGROUND: (b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

Program, Region 3 - Customer Service Hotline, Philadelphia, PA., received a call from an unidentified caller who made the following alleged threat, *"Pruitt is going to clean up the EPA. Stay out of our [s]tate Virginia"*.

According to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the call was received on the Region 3 Hotline # (800) 438-2474, and this number is also published on the EPA's website. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) advised that the caller did not identify him/herself. According to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) the number did not display, but rather showed as "Blocked". (b) (6), (b) (7) did not write down the time of the call. Due to the potential nature of the call (b) (6), (b) (7) notified (b) (6), (b) (7) chain of command.

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C) explained it is not uncommon to receive calls from a blocked number and that receiving calls from blocked numbers happens as little as five times a week; Monday through Friday. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) shared the notes (b) (6), (b) (7) took that day with the Case Agent, and (b) (6), (b) (7) referred to the notes as the February 3, 2017, phone log.

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The Case Agent reached out to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Facilities Management and Services Branch, Region 3, Philadelphia, PA 19103, and requested a print out of the call records from February 3, 2017, at (800) 438-2474, which is the Region 3 Customer Service Hotline number.

INVESTIGATIVE FINDINGS:

1. The investigative activity concluded that an unidentified person, called an EPA publicly advertised Hotline number, from a blocked number and made a demand, but not a clear threat.

2. On February 14, 2017, the Case Agent reviewed (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) February 3, 2017 phone log. As indicated by (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) did not record a time, and there is no number recorded on (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) log.

4. Upon examination of the postcard and rhetoric, statements such as, "Get out while you still can, Scott", "You are evil incarnite" and "you ignorant fuck" were hand written on the message portion of the postcard. Statements as such may not constitute a direct threat but are of concern to the Agency. The postcard is postmarked, "Boston, MA, 21 FEB 2017" and received in the Office of the Administrator on March 1, 2017. Also printed on the message side of the post card was the name of the image on the reverse side to be, "Symphony in Red" by James Abbott McNeill Whistler and the notation for the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston (MFA). It is unclear at this time of any conscience underlying message or significant meaning to the title of the image and

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correlation to it being sent to Administrator Pruitt. There was no sender information or signature recorded on the postcard.

OI inquired with the United States (US) Postal Inspection Service of the (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) and was met with negative results.

OI inquired with the Security Operations, Department of Protective Services, MFA, Boston, MA of the possibility in determining the origin of sale and/or a purchaser of the postcard could be determined. OI was told the postcard is not sold through outside vendors and most likely purchased at the MFA. As for determining when or whom may have purchased the postcard, OI was met with negative results.

OI inquired with the (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) (b) (7)(E) and was met with negative results.

DISPOSITION:

Because the postcard lacked a clear threat and the investigation was unable to determine a subject, the facts of this case were not presented to the United States Attorney's Office, District of Massachusetts for prosecutorial consideration.

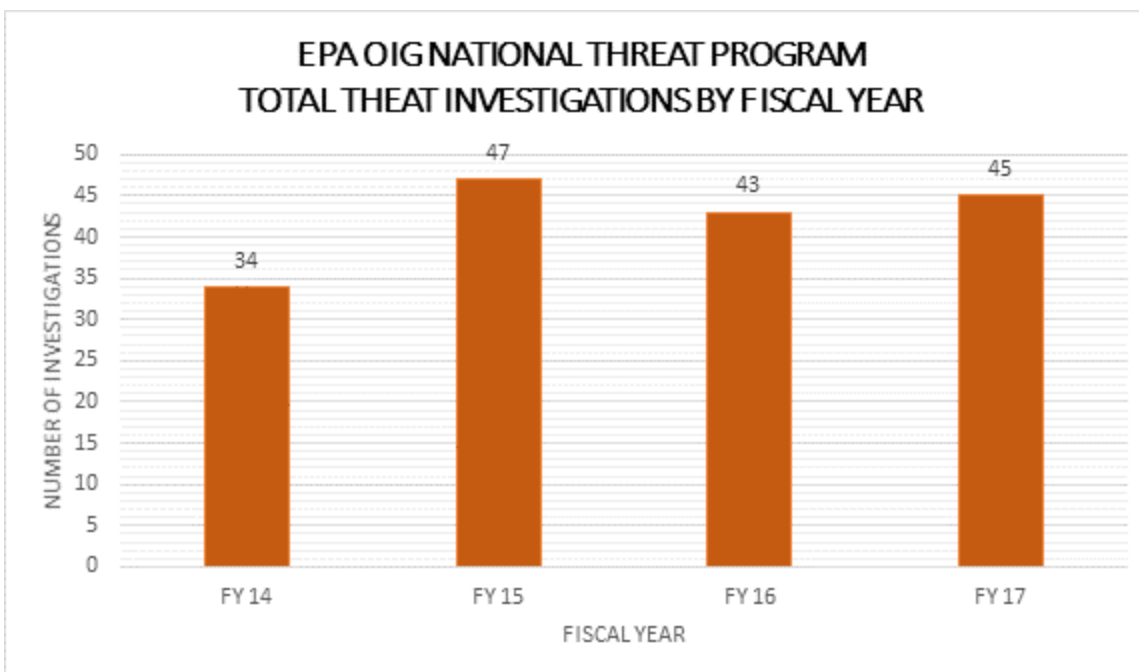
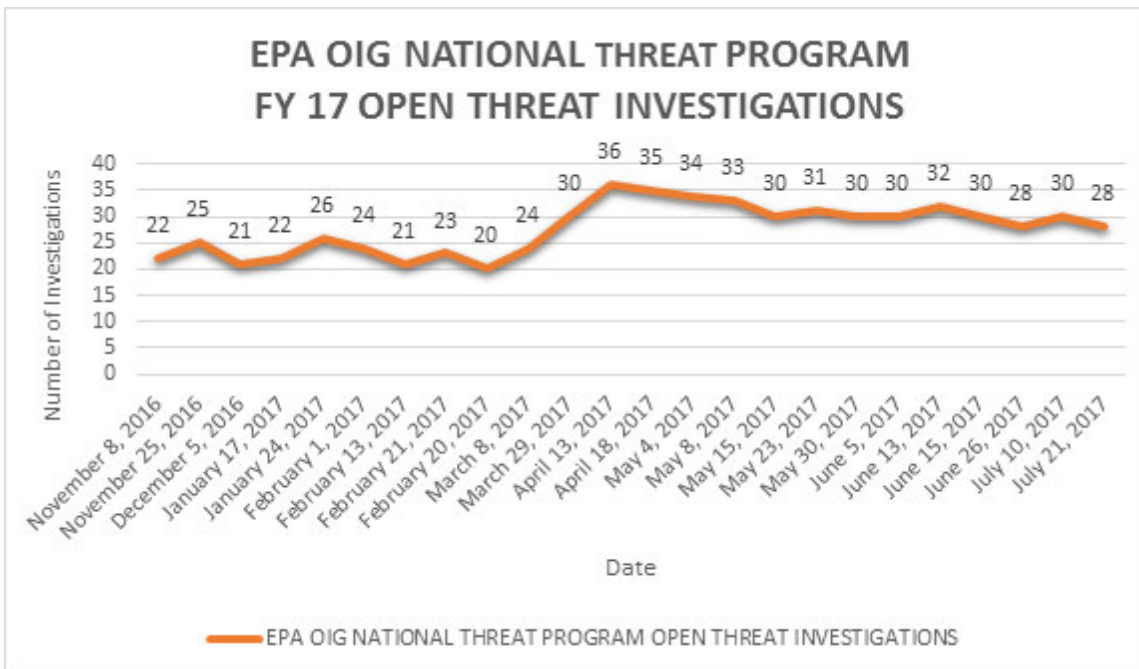
EPA NATIONAL THREAT PROGRAM DISTRIBUTION OF OPEN THREAT INVESTIGATIONS



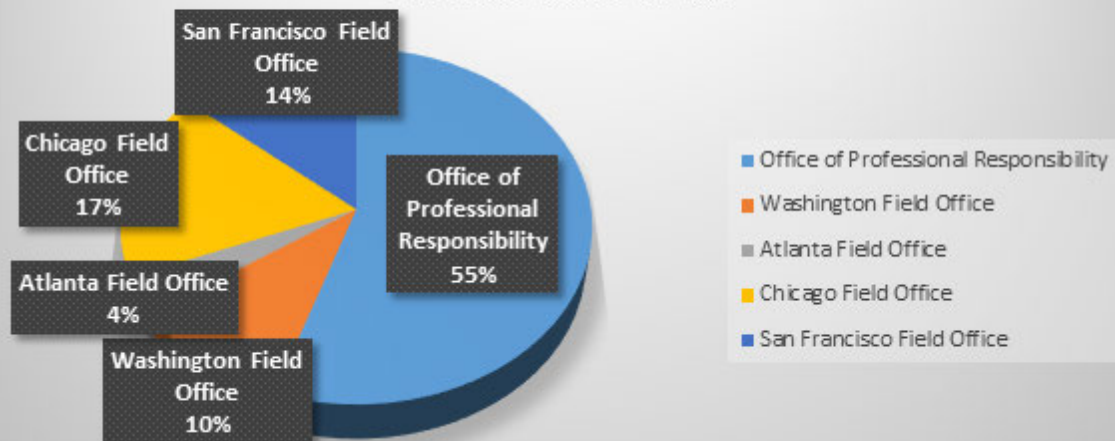

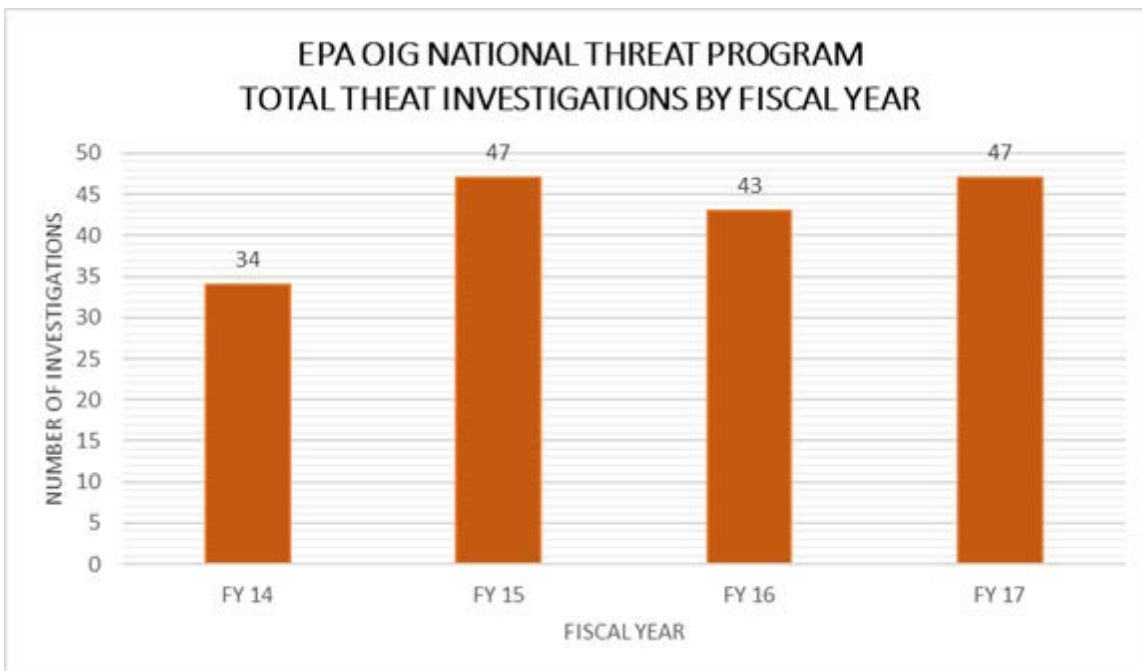
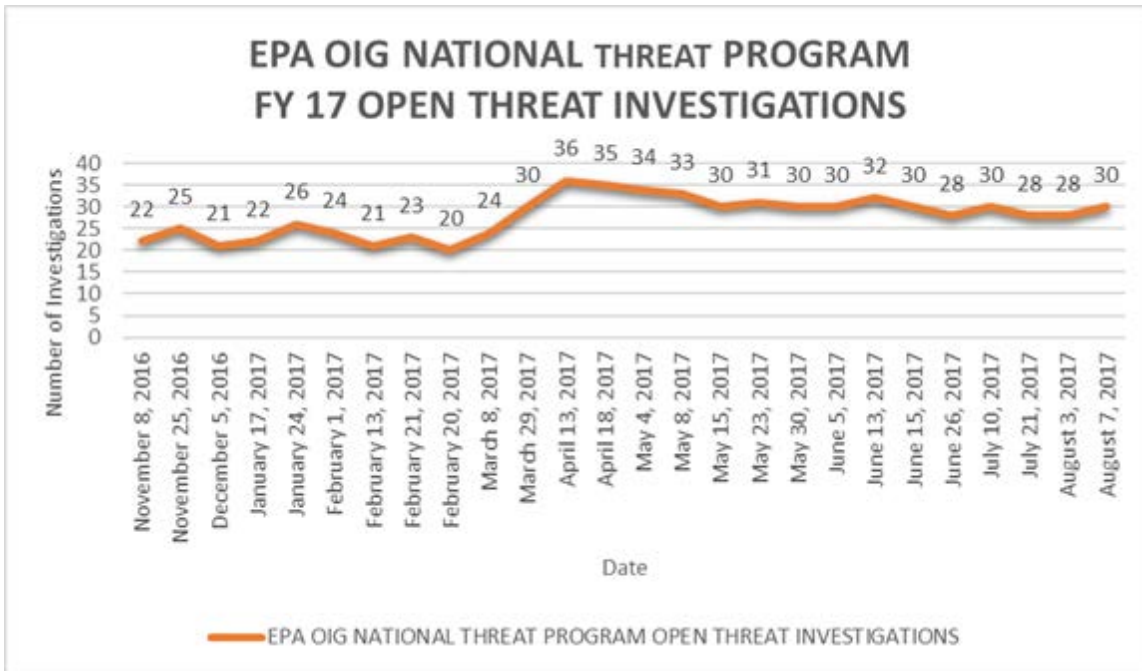
EPA OIG NATIONAL THREAT PROGRAM TOTAL THEAT INVESTIGATIONS BY FISCAL YEAR



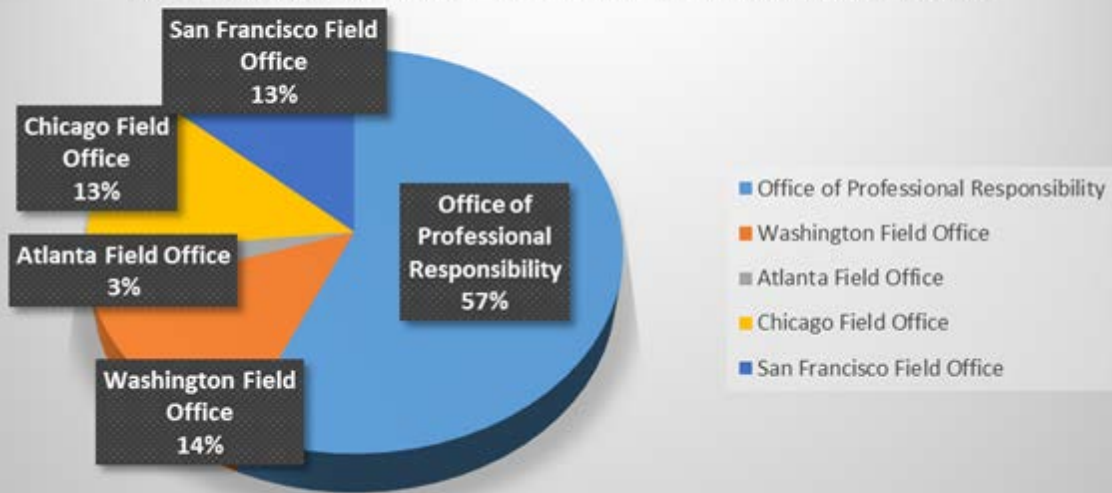

EPA NATIONAL THREAT PROGRAM DISTRIBUTION OF FY 2018 THREAT INVESTIGATIONS



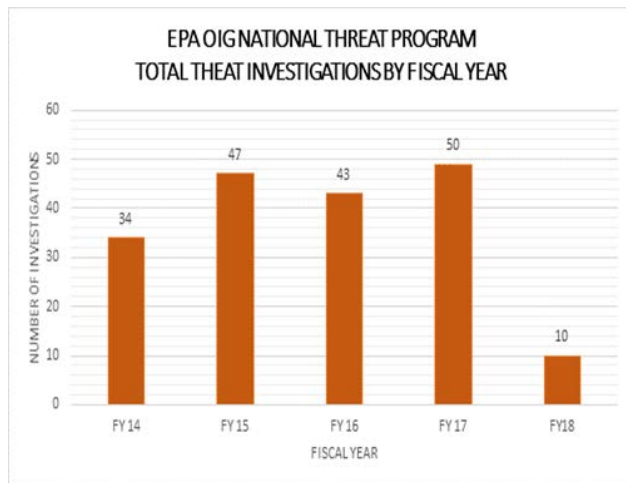

EPA NATIONAL THREAT PROGRAM DISTRIBUTION OF FY 2018 THREAT INVESTIGATIONS

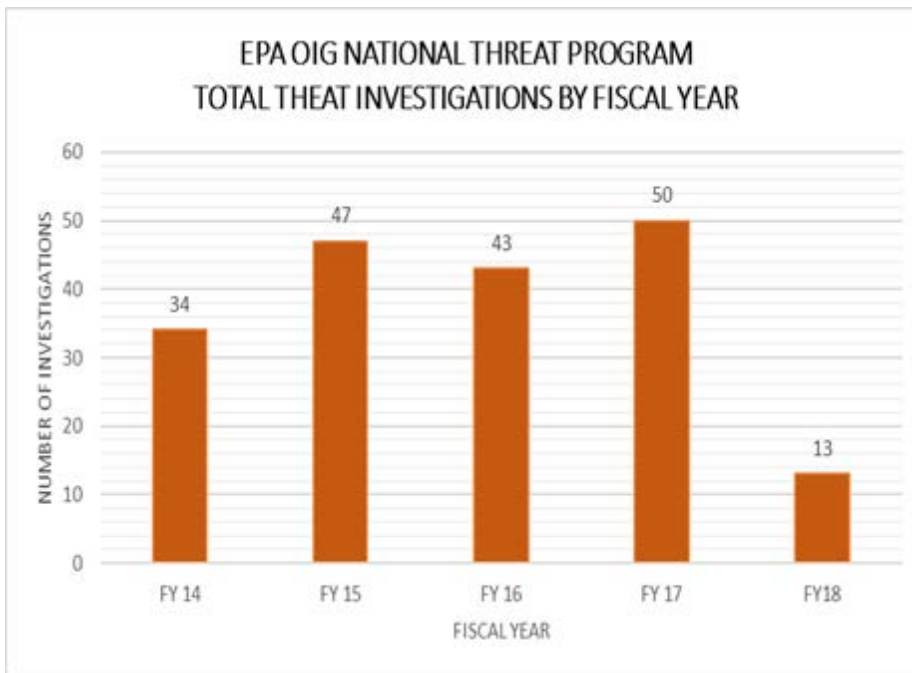

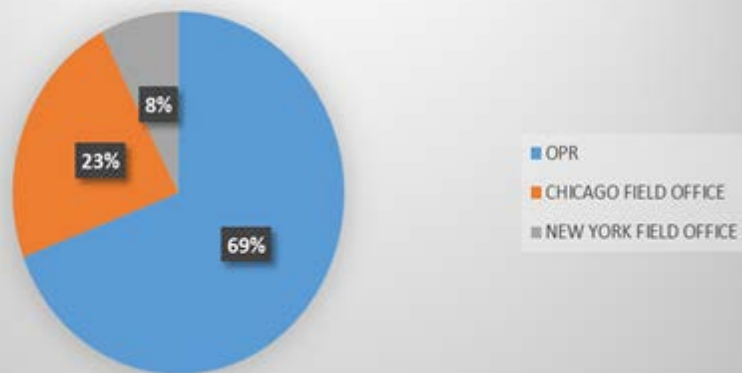
