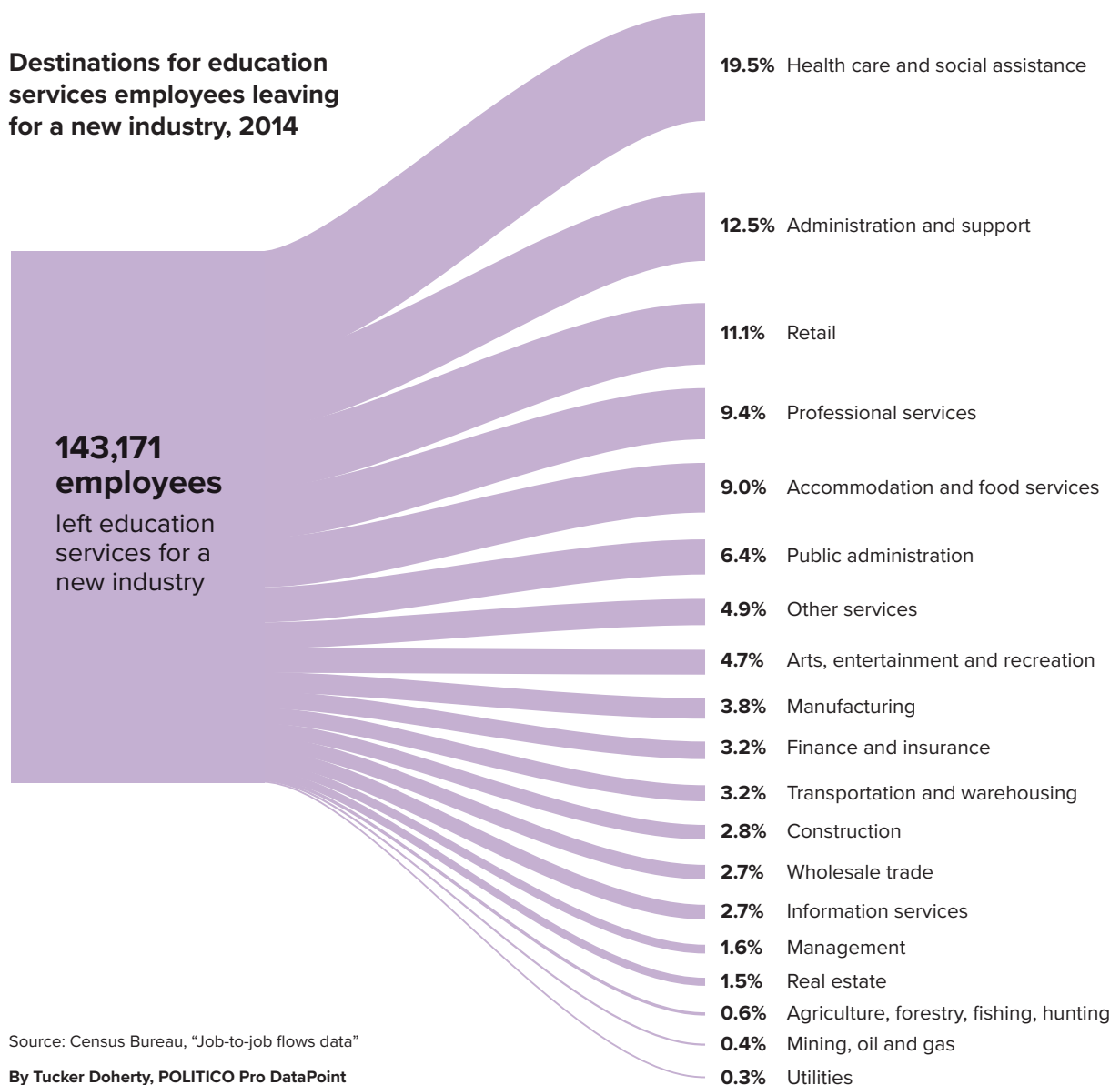

Where Teachers Work After Leaving Education

High turnover is a chronic problem in the education sector, with tens of thousands of teachers leaving for jobs in other industries each year. According to new data from the Census Bureau, it is a growing problem — between 2012 and 2014, the rate of job changes out of education services increased by approximately 5 percent.

Health care and social assistance was the most popular destination for former education workers, accounting for one out of every five job changes, followed by administrative jobs and retail trade.
