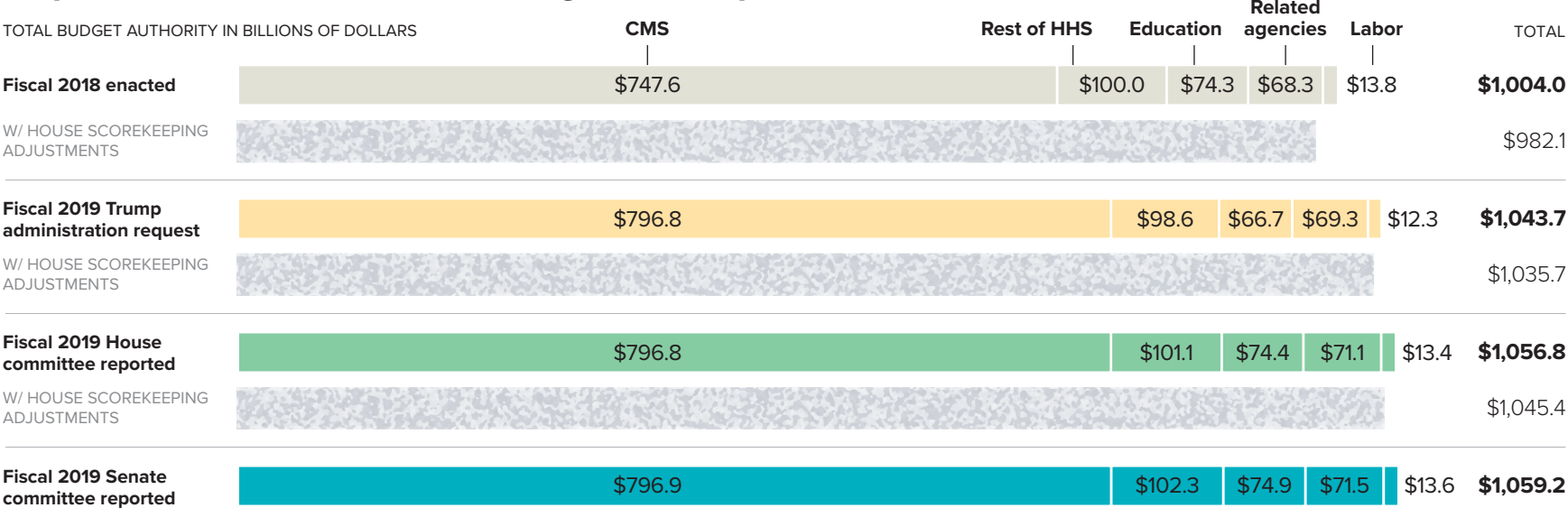

Fiscal 2019 Appropriations for Labor-HHS-Education

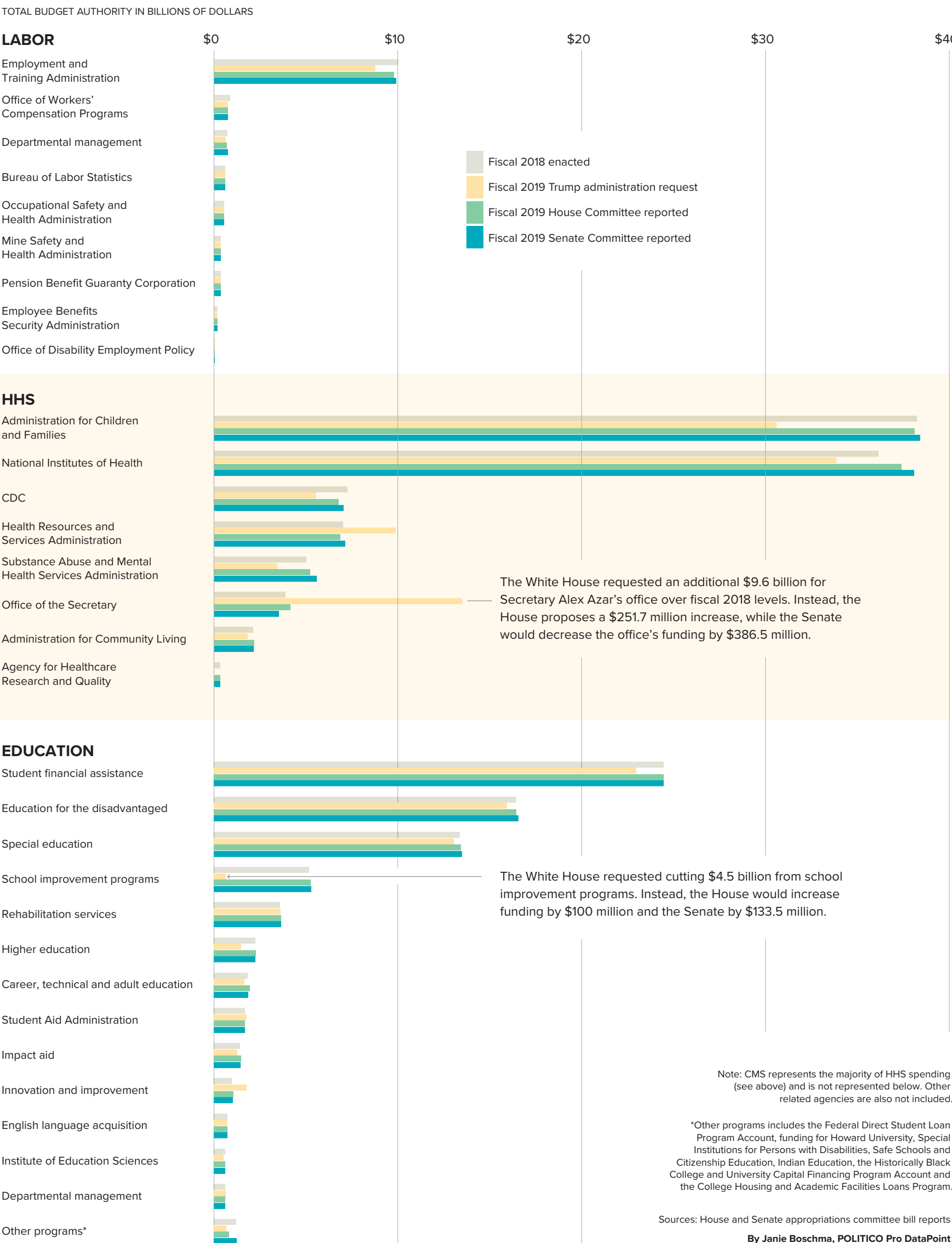
As is often the case, the Labor-HHS-Education bill may be the most difficult for the House and Senate to negotiate. The House version includes a series of rescissions and scorekeeping adjustments that bring down its topline \$13.8 billion below the Senate's. The House would defund Obamacare and eliminate several programs outright, including the Federal Direct Student Loan Program, the CDC Climate Change Program and teen pregnancy prevention grants, as requested by the White House. Several other programs proposed for elimination are likely to be spared, however, including the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality and the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.
