Dear Chairman Roberts, Chairman Conaway, Ranking Member Stabenow, and Ranking Member Peterson:

AgForward<sup>1</sup> – a non-partisan alliance of leading scientific societies, commodity groups, foundations, and associations – thanks you for your efforts on behalf of agriculture and agricultural research in developing the 2018 Farm Bill.

As your teams prepare for the work of the conference committee, we would like to present our positions on key research provisions within the House and Senate Farm Bills and our desired outcomes for the final Conference Bill:

## **Agricultural Research Funding**

- AgForward appreciates the House's inclusion of additional funding for the **Organic Agriculture Research and Extension Initiative (OREI)** and supports the Senate language which would make this program permanent at \$50 million for 2022 and beyond.
- AgForward appreciates the House's inclusion of renewed funding for the Beginning Farmer and
  Rancher Development Program (BFRDP) and supports the Senate language that would make this
  program permanent at \$50 million annually as part of the proposed Farming Opportunities
  Training and Outreach Program (FOTOP). Given that the proposed program would include two
  existing programs, we urge you to add more total funding to FOTOP in the Conference Bill to
  increase its BFRDP component.
- AgForward supports the Senate's inclusion of additional funds for the Foundation for Food and
  Agriculture Research (FFAR) and also recommends inclusion in the Conference Bill of a one time
  boost of mandatory funding for the Agriculture and Food Research Initiative (AFRI) as a down
  payment toward implementation of the research strategy recommendations presented in the July
  2018 National Academy of Sciences, Engineering and Medicine's Science Breakthroughs to
  Advance Food and Agricultural Research by 2030 report.

• AgForward recommends the inclusion of language within the Conference Bill acknowledging the importance of **doubling agricultural research funding** within the next decade in order to adequately meet the challenges facing our nation's producers, industries, and consumers.

## **USDA Program Management**

- AgForward supports the Senate's inclusion of language to strengthen staffing within the Office of
  the Chief Scientist, welcomes the Agriculture Advanced Research and Development Authority
  (AGARDA) pilot project, and recommends the addition in the Conference Bill of a Strategic
  Investment Fund (SIF) with specified agency contributions to provide the Chief Scientist with
  modest but immediate funding to improve collaboration in addressing emerging opportunities,
  urgent threats, and research requiring greater interdisciplinary approaches across multiple
  agencies.
- AgForward supports the Senate's language eliminating the mandatory matching fund requirements for competitive grant programs put in place in the 2014 Farm Bill.
- AgForward supports the recognition within both the House and Senate bills of the importance of international collaborations that leverage resources and advance priority food and agricultural interests of the United States.

AgForward would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you and your respective staffs to discuss these recommendations further and, if helpful, can provide language in support of these provisions.

Thank you for your consideration. We look forward to continuing to work with you in developing a Farm Bill Research Title that serves the vital needs our nation and restores our status as the world leader in agricultural research and innovation.
