- 3 "SEC. _____. (a) The Comptroller General of the
- 4 United States shall conduct a study on the condition of
- 5 the public school facilities of the United States and their
- 6 adequacy to support a 21st century education.
- 7 "(b) In conducting the study under subsection (a),
- 8 the Comptroller General shall study the following factors:
- 9 "(1) Structural integrity.
- 10 "(2) Plumbing.

1 “(3) Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning
2 systems.

3 “(4) Compliance with fire and safety codes.

4 “(5) Compliance with Federal laws, including
5 the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42
6 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.).

7 “(6) Lighting.

8 “(7) Indoor air quality.

9 “(8) Environmental conditions, such as expo-
10 sure to asbestos, lead, and mold.

11 “(9) Physical security.

12 “(10) Sufficient space for instruction.

13 “(c) The Comptroller General shall include in the
14 study under subsection (a) information on the ability of
15 States and local educational agencies to pay for necessary
16 repairs, renovation, and construction of public school fa-
17 cilities that are not in adequate condition, including plans
18 to finance the work within the next 10 years.

19 “(d) Not later than 18 months after the date of en-
20 actment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall submit
21 to the Committee on Appropriations and the Committee
22 on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate,
23 and the Committee on Appropriations and the Committee
24 on Education and the Workforce of the House of Rep-
25 resentatives, the findings of the study under this section.”.
