## Enforcement and Removal Operations Arrests and Removals– FY18 Q3

### **Key Points:**

- 90% of all aliens arrested to date in FY18 had a criminal conviction, faced a criminal charge, were an ICE fugitive or were processed with a reinstated final order.
- ICE has increased administrative arrests by 17% in FY2018 over the same period in FY2017.
- ICE has increased removals by 9% over the same period in FY2017.
- 61% of aliens without criminal convictions arrested by ICE in FY18 thus far came to ICE's attention due to criminal charges.
  - Some aliens in this group may in fact have criminal convictions, but are not classified as convicted criminal aliens because ICE is unable to verify the disposition of some criminal charges.
