




Trump Targets Over 5,000 Chinese Goods in Latest Tariff List

A 10 percent tariff on \$200 billion in Chinese goods that took effect Sept. 24 is in addition to the \$50 billion worth already taxed earlier this year — which means that about half of all U.S. imports that come from China now incur levies. The most recent round of tariffs includes a significant number of chemical and textile products, but the tariffs fall most heavily, by dollar value of 2017 imports, on machinery, electrical appliances and equipment.
