Highway	12/26/2018	Toms River, NJ	Passenger vehicle crashed into back of an oil tanker. 4 fatalities.
Highway	12/30/2018	Oxon Hill, MD	Pickup truck crashed into rear of passenger vehicle. 3 fatalities.
Rail	1/1/2019	Oakley, KS	Union Pacific freight train derailed and pinned employee between cars. 1 fatal.
Pipeline/Hazmat	1/2/2019	Charlotte, NC	Plantation Pipeline. Unknown amount of diesel fuel released from a transmission line and into a tributary.
