

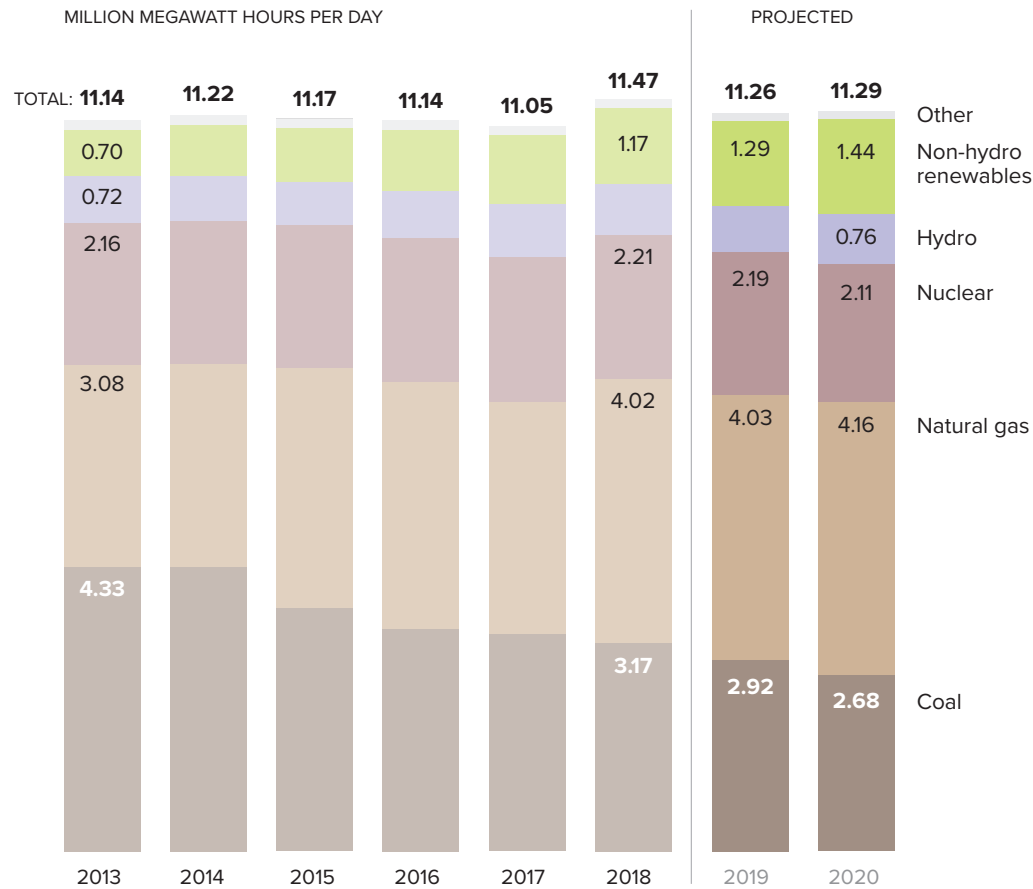

EIA Predicts Continued Growth of Renewables – and Natural Gas

Non-hydropower renewable sources of energy provided 10 percent of U.S. power generation in 2018, and are projected to increase their share to 13 percent in 2020, according to the Energy Information Administration's Short-term Energy Outlook. The report also foresees coal's share decreasing from 28 percent to 24 percent over the same period, but natural gas-fired plants' share increasing from 35 percent to 37 percent.

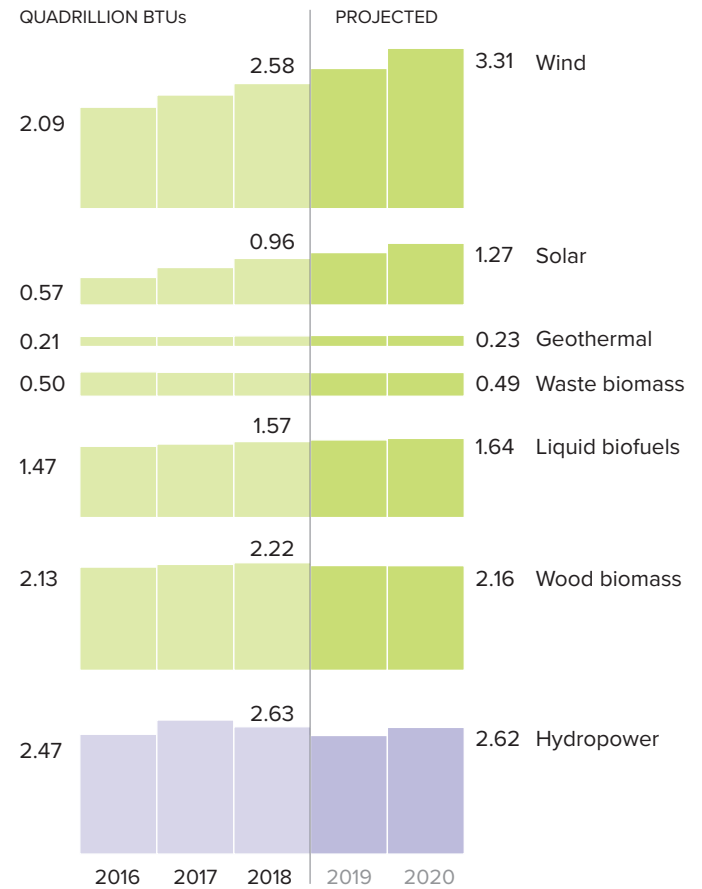
Electricity generation
