ORDER

On February 13, 2019, defendant filed a motion to suspend proceedings in this case pending resolution of the on-going proceedings in Martin, et al. v. United States, Case No. 13-834C, in which the parties are engaged in damages calculations. See ECF No. 9. See also Martin, ECF No. 191 (joint status report). Defendant contends that "[s]uspending proceedings in this case . . . pending a final decision in Martin, including any appeal, would greatly assist the Court and the parties in the efficient conduct of these proceedings." ECF No. 9 at 3.

The court does not agree. The process of calculating damages in <u>Martin</u>, in its current stage, is unlikely to impact the legal issues presented in this case. Should the posture of <u>Martin</u> change in a manner that would more directly impact this case, the parties may move the court to consider imposing a stay at that time. As such, defendant's motion to suspend proceedings in this case, ECF No. 9, is **DENIED**.
