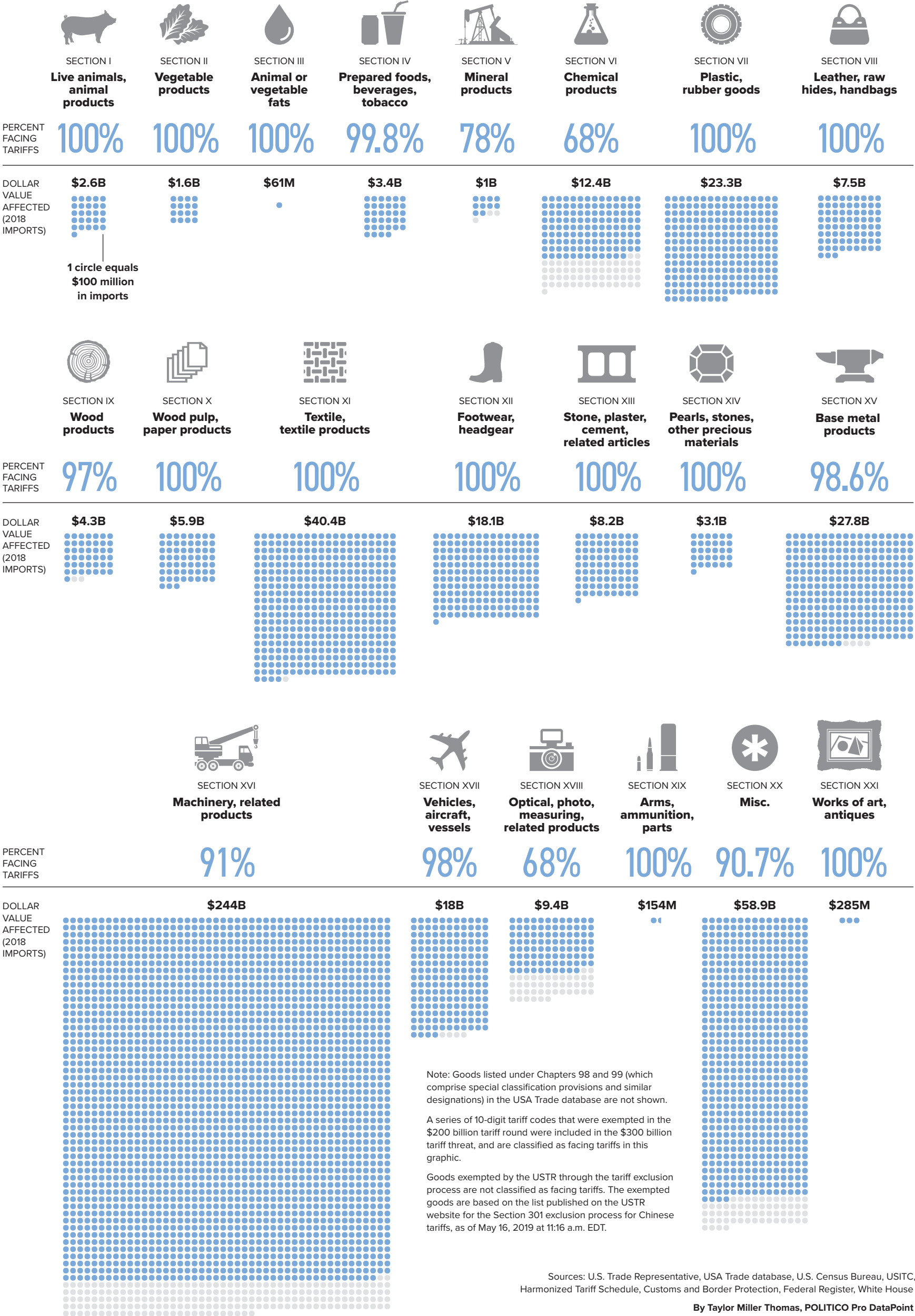

## Few Chinese goods have escaped Section 301 tariffs

Based on its Section 301 investigation, the U.S. has set or threatened tariffs on about 91 percent of all goods from China. The U.S. has recently said the administration is considering tariffs of up to 25 percent on \$300 billion worth of goods which have not yet been hit with tariffs. Goods from China have faced tariffs based on the United States' Section 301 actions as well as the steel and aluminum tariffs and antidumping and countervailing duty tariffs on solar panels and washing machines.
