Dear Senator Carper:

Thank you for your letter requesting that the Government Accountability Office review international sites that store or are contaminated by nuclear waste from United States activity and examine commitments the United States has made to clean up and maintain such sites.

GAO accepts your request as work that is within the scope of its authority. At the current time we anticipate that staff with the required skills will be available to initiate an engagement in about three months. Your request has been assigned to Mr. Mark E. Gaffigan, Managing Director, Natural Resources and Environment. Closer to the time GAO can start this engagement, Mr. Gaffigan or a member of his team will contact Ms. Michal Freedhoff to confirm that this request continues to be your priority for us. As applicable, we will also be in contact with the cognizant Inspector General's office to ensure that we are not duplicating efforts. If an issue arises during this coordination, we will consult with you regarding its resolution.
