Climate change policy positions of the Democratic presidential candidates

All 25 candidates for the 2020 Democratic presidential nomination say the U.S. should stick with the Paris agreement on combating climate change. But beyond that position, the candidates begin to differ: Four men have not ruled out taking campaign donations from fossil fuel industries, and two of those aren't keen on the Green New Deal. Only five candidates have set concrete goals for eliminating or reducing anthropogenic carbon emissions before midcentury.
