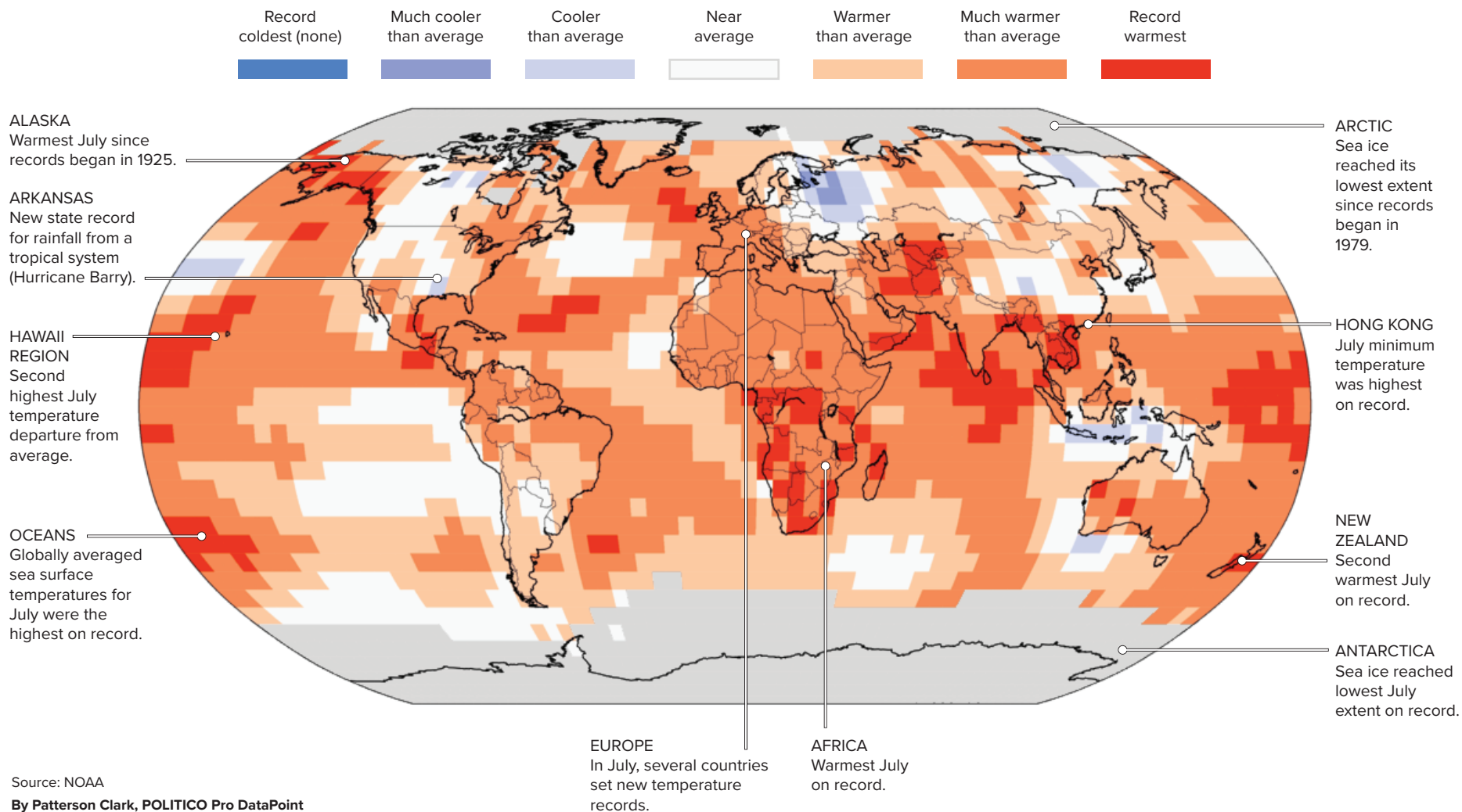

July was the hottest month ever recorded

July was the warmest month recorded since measurements began in 1880. The global land and ocean surface temperature departure from average July temperatures was 2.21°F above the 20th century average of 57.8°F, beating 2016's record by 0.05° F. The past five Julys have been the five warmest on record.
