USDA's climate hubs: Skeleton crews with a monumental task

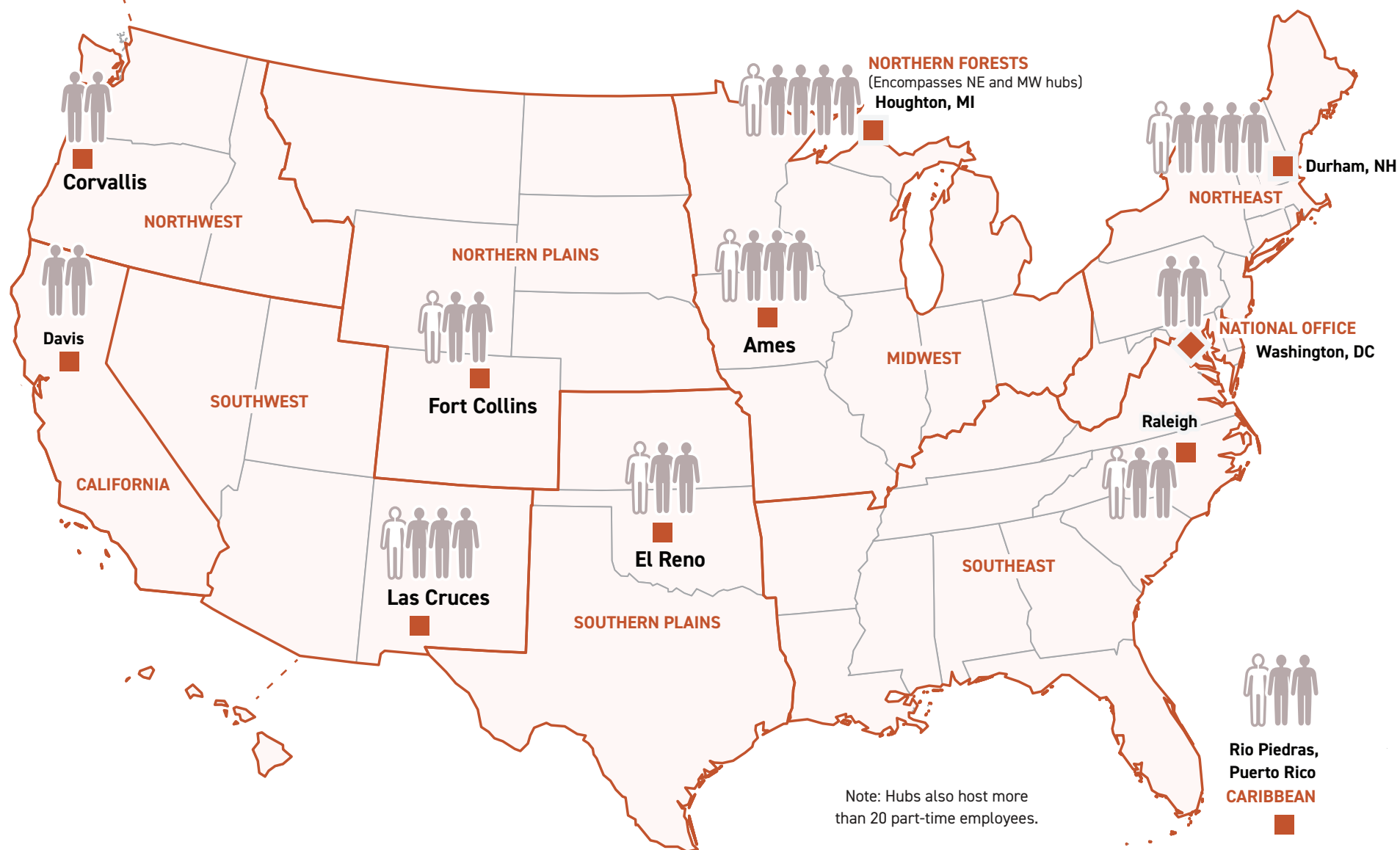
