

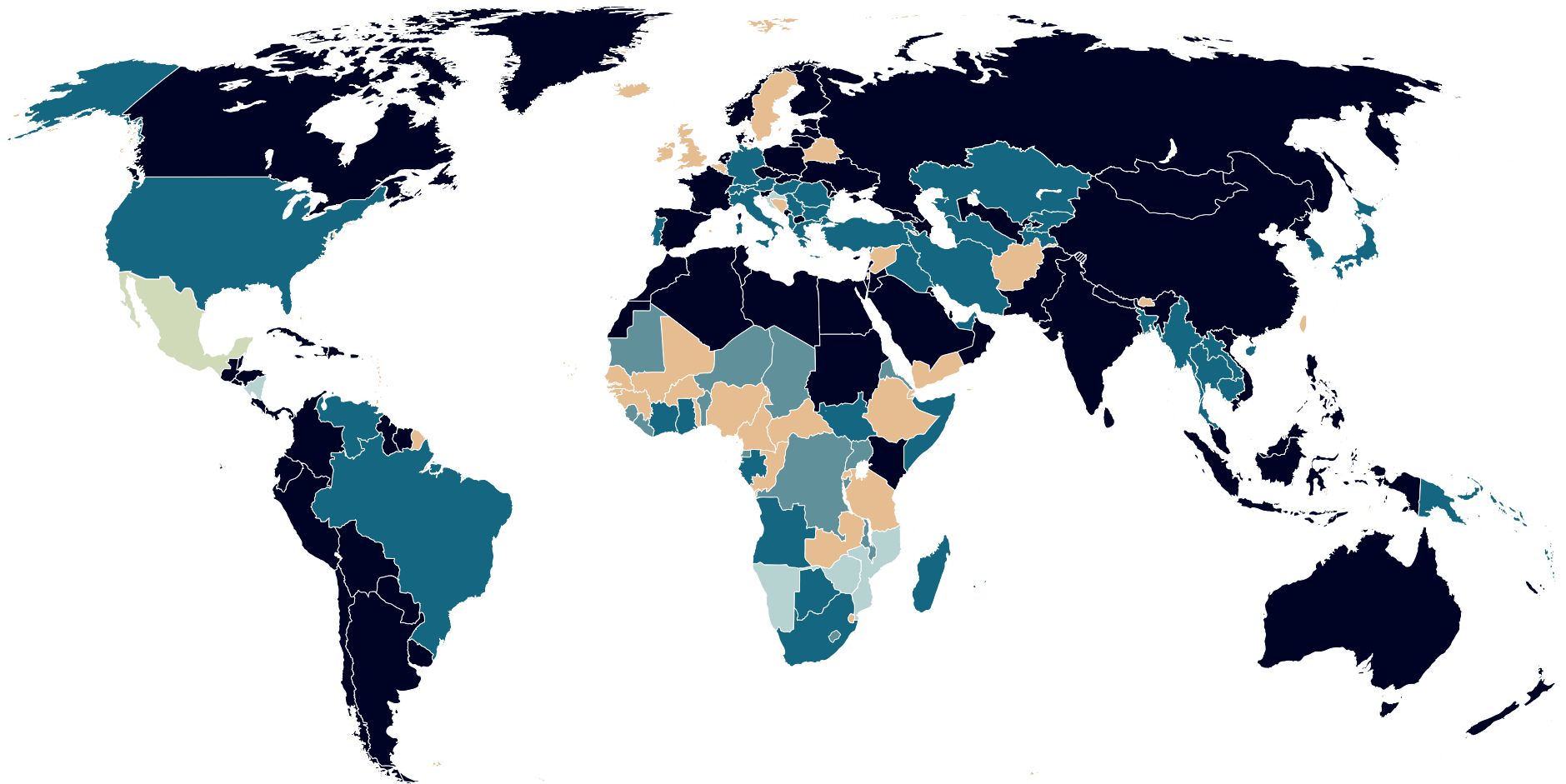
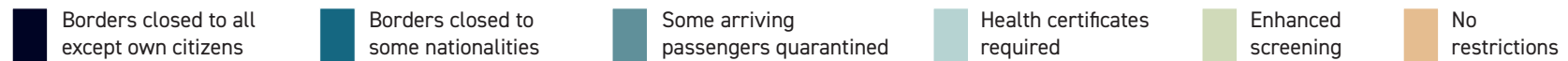

The International Air Transport Association says that closed borders, partial travel bans and quarantines for arriving passengers are affecting 98 percent of global passenger revenues. The organization projects a \$113 billion loss in global revenues for 2020.

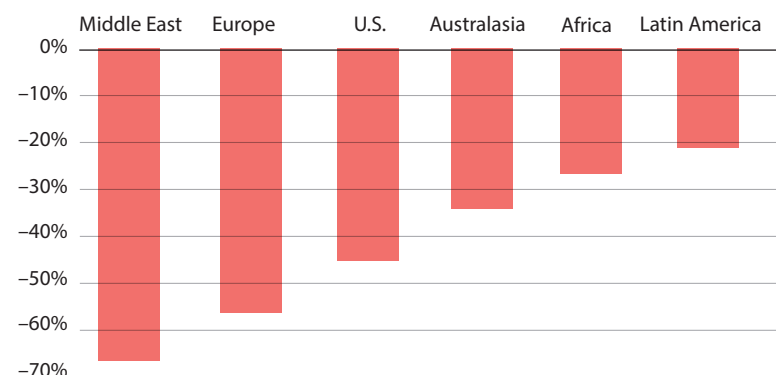

Global air travel collapses in March

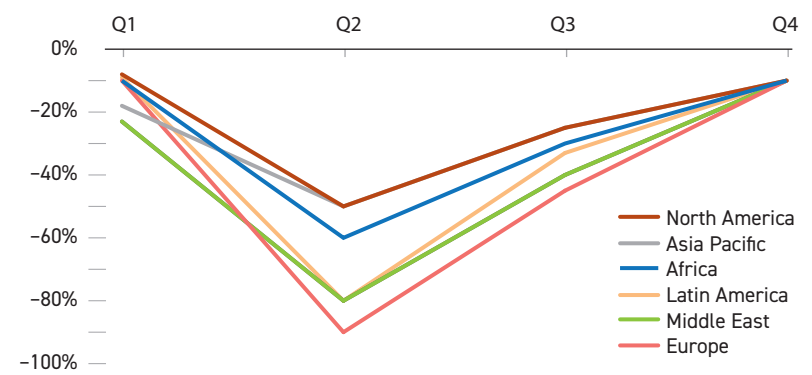
YEAR-ON-YEAR CHANGE IN NUMBER OF PASSENGERS IN MARCH
