Dear President-elect Biden and Vice President-elect Harris:

Congratulations on your historic victory. We commend your unwavering efforts to center the fight against climate change in your plans to rebuild our country.

We write today to recommend Mary Nichols to be the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
