Re: New York City Mayoral Polling

Slingshot Strategies, LLC. conducted a citywide poll of 1000 likely Democratic primary voters, assessing preferences in the upcoming primary election for Mayor of New York City.

Andrew Yang receives 25% of first-choice votes and a double-digit lead over his nearest rival, Eric Adams, whose share of first-choice votes has declined by 2 points since January to 15%. Yang remains dominant in Ranked Choice Voting, receiving 59% of votes in the final round.

- Andrew Yang's supporters are highly loyal, with 70% of Yang's first-choice voters
 "completely" or "very" certain about their selection. These voters don't just like Andrew,
 they are committed to him, and Yang receives a ranked vote from 52% of all voters, making
 him the only candidate to appear on more than 50% of ballots.
- An overwhelming majority (72%) of voters support Yang's signature program, a Basic Income that provides direct cash relief for New Yorkers.
- Perhaps tracking local news coverage, quality of life issues including crime and homelessness are increasingly top of mind for voters.
- Voters are **clamoring for a visionary (50%)** who can lead the recovery from COVID. They are not interested in a longtime politician (23%).
- The Yang coalition is coming into focus: it's multiracial, spans ideologies, and pulls from all five boroughs.

Andrew Yang continues to dominate head-to-head matchups against other leading candidates, beating Eric Adams 47% to 33%, Scott Stringer 52% to 27%, and Maya Wiley 54% to 20%.

Notably, the more voters learn about Andrew Yang and his competitors, the better Yang does. After an informed ballot test where poll respondents heard positive and negative messaging on the top six candidates, Andrew Yang climbed to 28% of first-choice votes, while Adams and Stringer saw no improvement.

Yang's gains continue into Ranked Choice Voting, defeating Eric Adams 61% to 39% in the final round of calculations.

Slingshot Strategies conducted a multimodal poll with a random representative sample of 1000 registered, likely Democratic primary voters from March 12-18, 2021. Sample breakdown by borough was 31% Brooklyn, 29% Manhattan, 21% Queens, 13% Bronx, 6% Staten Island.
